By-Laws Applicable To The Cattle Section

- 57 All cattle must be entered in the name of the bona-fide owner.
- 58 The date of birth of all breeding cattle must be stated at the time of entry.
- 59 The age of cattle shall be computed as at 1st June.
 - **NB:** As the age of all cattle is determined from the 1st June in each year, all animals shall be deemed to be one year older on this date.
- 61 All cattle entered in groups or in special classes must be entered in at least one other single entry class if and for which they are eligible.
- 62 Cows and heifers calving after entry has been made, may be transferred to the classes for which they have become eligible.
- 63 In all applicable classes of female stock, Judges to withhold awards for cattle which in their opinion, are barren.
- 65 All pedigree cattle one year old and over must be registered with a recognised breed society and no bull or heifer under two years of age shall be eligible for senior championships.
- 66 Manawatu A & P Assn reserves the right to amalgamate classes where there are insufficient entries. Any Breed without two exhibitors with six animals will be transferred to other Registered Breeds Sections.

Exhibitors Information

Rules and Regulations

The rules and Regulations as issued by the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand (Inc) for the governance and conduct of A & P Shows have been adopted by the Manawatu & West Coast A & P Association. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to be conversant with these rules. Copies of the Rules and Regulations are available on request.

General

- a) We reserve the right to amalgamate classes on the day, when there is only one entry. In this case, the exhibitor has the right to move up a class, or stay in the age group and receive a ribbon only. All other exhibits must be shown in their respective age group.
- b) Exhibitors are requested not to tether stock in Judging Rings.
- c) All cattle entered in the purebred classes must be entered, if one year old or over, in the recognised Herd Book of the breed concerned. If under one year of age, they must be eligible for entry. The names and pedigree of all such cattle must be stated on the Entry Form and if the exhibitor is not the breeder, the breeder's name must also be stated.
- d) For exhibitors travelling from Waikato and North of there, may enter the showgrounds from Wednesday 5th November. All other exhibitors may enter from Thursday 6 November

TB Testing

All cattle including yearlings entered for this Show must be from a TB free and accredited Herd within the preceding 12 months. Cattle from a TB and accredited herd within a declared Movement Control Area must be tested and passed within 60 days of movement.

A copy of the Test Certificate must accompany all entry forms.

Checks will be made for TB declaration cards on stock arrival.

All animals must comply with current Animal Health Board regulations.

INSPECTION: The Committee reserves the right to inspect at random any cattle for tattoos or identification to establish TB Status.

NAIT: For cattle being moved from 1 July 2012: A NAIT approved RFID tag is mandatory for all movements of cattle, including day old calves. NAIT approved RFID cattle tags are white only. Please do not remove tags if cattle are identified with Animal Health Board or MINDA tags.

As of 1 July 2012 a secondary tag is no longer required under the new NAIT scheme. All animals being exhibited at the Show come under the standard identification and ASD regulations. These cattle will require the NAIT approved RFID tag.

It is the livestock exhibitors responsibility to record all animal movements with NAIT 48 hours prior to leaving the farm/property for the Show and then within 48 hours of returning to the farm/property from the Show.

Feed Requirements

The Association is unable to provide paddocks for stock on the grounds. Green feed will not be available.

Auxiliary Equipment Not Permitted

In the interest of safety and tidiness in the Pavilion. Exhibitors will not be permitted to bring any items of electrical equipment into the Pavilion. This includes auxiliary milking plant, water heating equipment, cooking appliances etc. Blow driers and clippers are allowed. A designated area will be provided where blow driers and clipping shoots can be used.

Stalling Of Entries

In the event of catalogued entries not being exhibited at the Show, the Chief Steward shall have the right to re-allocate such stall spaces.

NB: It is a requirement of all exhibitors to keep their area clean and tidy throughout the duration of the show.

NO STRAW is to be brought onto the grounds. Sawdust bedding will be available for all animals. Feed receptacles will not be provided in the Cattle Pavilion. Exhibitors wishing to feed meal or dry stock foods should bring suitable containers with them. Water troughs are located in convenient positions in the Pavilion. If extra sawdust is required, exhibitors are required to provide this at their own expense.

Limitation on Entries

The Committee reserves the right to limit entries. Exhibitors are directed to the conditions and bylaws set out in each Schedule. If any entry has to be refused, entry fees will be refunded in full.

Vehicle Parking

Exhibitor entry is via Kawa Kawa Road, Feilding, Gate 5. Please park in the area provided for Exhibitors of the Dairy Section.

Basic Prize Money and Entry Fees

The rates shown for members are applicable to members of the Manawatu & West Coast A & P Association. Application for membership will be welcomed from prospective members on the basis of a continuing commitment. All stated entry fees and prize money are GST inclusive.

Points

Competition means two or more exhibitors, who exhibit in a particular class for which prizes are awarded. Ties to count one win each. For points prizes, no additional points will be awarded for Supreme or Grand Champions.

In the event of two exhibitors or more gaining equal points, the exhibitor gaining most first prizes will be declared the winner. If points are still equal, the exhibitor being awarded most Championships will be declared the winner.

Prize Ribbons

In the cattle sections, ribbons will be presented to all first, second, and third prizewinners; Sashes to Champion All Breeds Cow and Champion All Breeds Bull, as well as Champion and Reserve Champions in classes, as shown.

1. Age of exhibitor 12-21 inclusive as at 1st February of that current show season.

- 2. Enter on the day; no entry fee.
- 3. Prize money Individual Shows 1st \$70, 2nd \$50,& 3rd \$30 worth of R D 1 Vouchers.
- 4. Animal to be either In-milk or Yearling Heifer (no calves).
- 5. Animals to have no horns.
- 6. To be judged on Presentation (of the handler) and Handling.
- 7. Time limit for judging- maximum of 20 minutes or shorter at the discretion of the Coordinator

- 8. Exhibitor to enter animal of their choice during the judging they will be asked to change animals by random draw.
- 9. Exhibitors to reside in either W D C or E D C Areas. (Note; E D C exhibitors may compete at individual shows for prize money and ribbons but not be eligible to accumulate points towards the Western Districts trophy.
- 10. To be judged by a panel of nominated breed judges. The adjudicating judges will operate from outside the ring. A ring Steward will assist the Ring Judge so as competitors reaction to their instructions can be gauged. Judges decision to be final One of the Judges will be nominated 'Chief Judge' prior to the commencement of the class.
- 11. Points 1st 5 pts, 2nd 4pts, 3rd 3 pts, 4th 2pts, 5th1pt.

The Western District Council points to be awarded in accordance with placing on the day e.g. Western District highest place getter may be 2nd and is awarded 4 points not 5 as for 1st placing.

- 12. In the event of a tie at individual shows for any place: The highest placing of the two will be awarded to the exhibitor with the highest placing on the Chief Judges result sheet.
- 13. In the event of there being a tie in the final placings of the "Western District Council Young Handler", the exhibitor with the highest number of highest placings will be deemed the overall winner.
- 14. Exhibitor to reside in Western District Council area.
