## Show Hunter Classes 2015 – Canterbury Championship Show

- Show Hunter classes run under ESNZ Show Hunter Rules 2014, & SHNZ Equitation Series Conditions 2014
- All riders jumping above 80cm must be members of ESNZ
- Riders jumping 80cm or below may enter on a community membership
- All horses/ponies may start in any class under the “flexi-start” system **with the exception of Series Classes** where horses/ponies must hold an annual start registration
- Horses with an annual start registration will gain HoY points in classes designated HoY
- Rising Star Division and Young Horse Division:
  - Run over three shows – Labour Weekend, Xmas Cracker and Canterbury Champs.
  - Three classes qualify per show – under saddle and two jumping classes
  - **Makerikeri Silviculture Ltd and Robyn and Paul Woods** sponsor a rug and sash to winners of these points prizes
  - **The Irish Horse Society** will award a sash to the highest placed Irish bred horse in the Rising star classes over this show and the Canterbury Champs. If no Irish horse is placed in the series, then the sash will go to the Irish horse with the best score over 65%. Irish horse owners must put their Irish Horse Society Registration number on their entry form
- Amateur Championship:
  - Run over three shows – Labour Weekend, Xmas Cracker and Canterbury Champs.
  - **Makerikeri Silviculture Ltd and Robyn and Paul Woods** sponsor a rug and sash to winners of this points prize
- Pony rider in their first season division:
  - Run over three shows – Labour Weekend, Xmas Cracker and Canterbury Champs.
  - Points from the highlighted classes will be allocated – one under saddle and two jumping classes
  - Sashes to 5<sup>th</sup> sponsored by **K&L Contracting Ltd and Lucy and Kerry Maley**
- Pony Points Prize
  - Run over three shows – Labour Weekend, Xmas Cracker and Canterbury Champs.
  - Points from two qualifying classes per show to count **in the correct category for the pony**
  - **Makerikeri Silviculture Ltd and Robyn and Paul Woods** sponsor a Trophy and rug to the winner and sashes to 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>
- Children’s Equitation Trophy – **Sandpit Trophy donated by L Maley, D Scott and R Woods**
  - All first place getters in any Children’s Equitation/Hunt Seat Equitation at the three Canterbury shows to qualify for a final at the Canterbury Championship show
- A **Field Hunter** is a horse that has hunted or ridden by a member of a hunt
- **The Irish Horse Society** will award a sash to the Irish horse with the highest percentage in all HoY classes over the two days of this show (and one will be awarded at the Canterbury Champs). Irish horse owners must put their Irish Horse Society Registration number on their entry form
- **The Irish Horse Society** will award a sash to the Irish horse with the highest place in the in 5, 6 and 7yo series. If no Irish horse is placed in the series, then the sash will go to the Irish horse with the best score over 65%. Irish horse owners must put their Irish Horse Society Registration number on their entry form
- Low Hunter conditions (as per the ESNZ Show Hunter Rules):
  - Horses may enter Low Hunter and Training classes **OR** Introductory and Open classes (ie not Low Hunter and Open classes)

- Registered entries must be made on official ESNZ entry forms and include horse & rider registration numbers.
- **Payment must be included with entries – no phone or fax entries accepted.**
- **Late entries: Plus 50% and will only be accepted from horses/riders entered in the show before show day. No completely new entries on the day.**
- A fee of \$2 per class will be made for class changes and jump first after late entries
- **No refunds payable for entries received after closing date of entries.**
- **Scratchings:** to be advised by 8am each day of competition.
- **Refunds:** less 20% per horse/pony upon presentation of medical / veterinary certificate or at the discretion of the organising committee.
- The Committee reserves the right to alter, amend or delete any class or prize money.
- Hacks / Ponies may start in only **ONE** Championship class or Mini Prix or Grand Prix
- **Star Spotters:** Horses not to have had ANY wins at 1.10m or greater at closing date of entries. A1's excluded.
