- A fee of \$2 per class will be made for class changes
- Late entries: Plus 50%.
- No refunds payable for entries received after closing date of entries.
- Scratchings: to be advised by 8am each day for that day's competition.
- Refunds less 20% per horse/pony upon presentation of medical / veterinary certificate or at the discretion of the organising committee.
- Hacks / Ponies may start in only ONE Championship class or Mini Prix or Grand Prix.

- ESNZ horse registration ID paper is required for all horses and must be available for the veterinary delegate at the horse inspection
- All horses competing will be allocated a three digit horse ID number
- All SI entries MUST provide assistance
