This includes the Health & Safety Act 1992.
- Novice Horses or Ponies not to have won more than 5 wins in A & P events.
- Adults may ride novice ponies in novice classes only
- Height Certificates and Novice Performance cards must be carried at all times.
- Unregistered horse or rider may compete in Show Jumping classes 216 & 280 but must pay the \$5 ESNZ jumping levy. Ribbons only these classes. **Riders must be ESNZ full or community members.**

- All objections or protests must be lodged in writing within an hour accompanied with a \$50.00 fee. Judicial Committee
