# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

ENTRIES CLOSE: WEDNESDAY 30th NOVEMBER 2016

General Rules and Regulations for the governance and conduct of the Te Kauwhata A & P Show shall be the same as previously. If any exhibitor is not sure of the conditions they should get in touch with the Secretary.

The use of tranquilisers, stimulants or any drug capable of affecting the performance of horses or ponies is forbidden. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the show and that testing of all animals is at the owners' risk. Your signature on the entry form and / or participation in the competition denotes acceptance of these conditions.

#### Entry Fees must accompany the forms when handed to Secretary otherwise the entries will not be accepted. Entries made by telephone must be immediately confirmed in writing, accompanied by entry fees.

Administration Fees are added to your entry form, these cover Public Liability Insurance, Ground Cover and Drug Levy to RAS, and postage.

NB: **R.A.S. Height Certificates are to be carried at all times** and must be produced ringside if asked. Prize money may be withheld if not produced when asked.

The Association will not be responsible for any accident in competitions or that may occur from machinery or other exhibits or plants belonging to exhibitors, competitors or the Association and it is a condition of entry that such exhibitor, competitor or visitor shall hold the Association blameless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings issuing from any accidents so caused.

The attention of exhibitors is particularly drawn to the conditions relating to the misuse of drugs and the intention of the Association to undertake testing for forbidden substances.

1. Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the showgrounds.

2. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate Animal Legislation and the Health & Safety in Employment Act 1992,

3. No person is permitted in any judging ring without express permission from the Head Steward of that ring.

4. Only persons directly responsible for an exhibit are permitted in the marshalling area.

5. Te Kauwhata A&P Association will be implementing the yellow card system whereby, any unsportsmanship or abuse of stewards, judges, fellow competitors, or animals will not be tolerated.

6. Horses may enter only one Section - Park Hack, Hack, Riding Horse or Saddle Hunter.

7. No classes will be held up for competitors competing in other rings, there are no exceptions.

8. **R.A.S. Height Certificates are to be carried at all times**. Prize money may be withheld if not produced when asked.

9. Approved safety helmets must be worn in all jumping classes.

10. A Newcomer horse or pony must have started the 2016/2017 season as a novice.

#### REFUND OF ENTRY FEES:

11. If a pony or horse is entered for the show but the animal or rider through injury is prevented from competing at the Show, and a Veterinary or Doctor's certificate confirming the fact is received at the Secretary's office by the 10th December, 50% of the entry fees paid are refundable.

If the horse or pony competes at the Show or the respective certificates are not received within the specified time the right to receive a refund is forfeited.

#### ENTRY FEES & PRIZE MONEY:

12. Members of the Te Kauwhata A&P Association are entitled to a \$2 discount on each class entered. You can pay for or renew a membership with your entry fees.

13. Te Kauwhata A&P reserve the right to exchange prize money for products when available. 14. Prize money will be reduced to 1st and 2nd place if only 4 in class, 1st only if 3 in a class and the value of 2nd placing if 2 or less in the class. Where there are 5 or more entries in the class, then full prize money will be paid out.

#### LATE ENTRIES:

15. Late entries will be accepted up until 8.15 am on show day at a fee of standard entry fee plus 25%. All classes will be on Saturday 10th December.

#### BACK NUMBERS:

16. All horses entered in equestrian classes are to provide and wear their numbers allocated to them to be used throughout the classes.
