

RULES, REGULATIONS, ENTRIES & FEES Friday 17th, Saturday 18th & Sunday 19th February 2017 Solway Showgrounds, Judds Road, Masterton

CHIEF HORSE MARSHALL: Ms Christine Rowe DEPUTY: Mrs Tinks Pottinger

THE HORSE SECRETARY'S OFFICE: Situated under the Judges Box on the Eastern side of the Solway Oval (opposite the Grandstand). Open during the show for all Horse Section enquiries, transfers, etc.

RULES: Copies of Rules and Regulations are available on application and all entries are accepted on the clear understanding that the rules will be adhered to. The Judge or person nominated by the Committee may demand the production of performance cards or other proof that the horse/pony is currently registered (when registration is obligatory Rule 30 NZEF). For hack and pony competitions a valid RAS Height Certificate is to be produced when required.

FORBIDDEN SUBSTANCES: The Rules of the Royal A&P Society New Zealand in regard to Forbidden Substances apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the person responsible's risk. Forbidden Substance - Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, muscoskeletal or urogenital systems.

YELLOW CARD: This Show/Event supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system. A Yellow Card will be issued, In cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. Full wording of the 'Yellow Card' system is available to view on the RAS website – www.ras.org.nz.

ARREARS: No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other Show/Event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.

SUMMARY OF RAS RESOLUTION PROCESS: the full process can be found on the RAS website www.ras.org.nz. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the show. If the matter is in regards to an RAS official, the show may request the assistance of RAS Head Office as to how to deal with this in an appropriate manner.

PLEASE NOTE: Each Exhibitor must supervise their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created, accidents, illness or damage caused by the actions of



themselves or their animals at the Solway Showgrounds. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1993.

HORSES OR PONIES LOOSE ON THE GROUNDS WILL BE IMPOUNDED.

DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE OVALS AND MUST BE ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: A hard hat is generally described as a hunting cap, a bowler, protective headwear or a safety helmet. Wearing of a hard hat is compulsory for anyone competing on, working in or schooling, or riding, or for any other reason, a horse/pony at an A&P Show or in any area considered to be for whatever reason, a part of the Showgrounds. All riders 16 years and under must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chin strap properly adjusted and fastened when mounted within the Showgrounds.

PROTESTS: Protests must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of class being completed with a fee of \$50.00 which will be refunded only if protest is upheld.

ABUSE OF SHOW OFFICIALS WILL RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION, AS WILL PARKING IN NON-DESIGNATED AREAS. CUTTING AND DRESSAGE WHIPS ALLOWED ONLY IN DRESSAGE SECTION.

PLEASE CHECK YOUR TROPHIES THOROUGHLY AND RETURN THOSE THAT ARE THE PROPERTY OF MASTERTON A & P SHOW IN CLEAN CONDITION AT, OR BEFORE, SHOWTIME - THANK YOU.

ENTRIES: ENTRIES CLOSE Friday 10th Febuary 2017: Post to: Victoria Martin, Show Secretary, PO Box 496, Masterton. On Line Entries available at www.main-events.com

THE ASSOCIATION HAS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY ENTRY MASTERTON A&P ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP FEE: \$35.00

ENTRY FORMS: Entry Forms must clearly state the class number, name and address of entrant, name of horse/pony, name of exhibitor/rider at time of entry. ENTRIES WHICH DO NOT COMPLY AND ARE NOT PAID IN FULL WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

LATE ENTRIES: A late entry is defined as an animal not officially entered (on the Entry Form) in the Show by the closing date specified in the Schedule. Late entries are accepted with a 50% penalty.

ENTRIES DURING THE SHOW: Competitors will be able to place additional entries during the course of the Show. This will apply only to animals that are already entered/competing at the Show. Additional entries will carry a 50% surcharge on the entry fee, which must be paid at the time the additional entry is made. These entries can only be made at the Secretary's Office up to 1hr preceding the competition. These entries will then be processed and updated sheets produced for Stewards for the competition. There will be no exception or variance to these details.



SHOWJUMPING TRANSFERS: Competitors may transfer an entered horse/pony to a different class under the following conditions:

Transfer form completed and fee of \$2.00 per transfer plus entry fee difference paid at the Horse Secretary's office. Transfers must be notified at least one hour before the start of the class you are transferring to. Transferred entries will be the first to jump.

ENTRY OF SUBSTITUTIONS: Horse/Pony may be substituted only into original class, and must be property of the same person as the original entry.

SCRATCHINGS & REFUND OF ENTRY FEES: 75% of Entry Fees will be refunded for scratching before the 11 Feb 2017 ONLY if notified in writing to the show secretary. 50% of Entry Fees will be refunded for scratchings ONLY if notified in writing the day before the class is to be run.

THERE ARE NO REFUNDS FOR ANY SUM UNDER \$20.00.

HEIGHT/PERFORMACE CARDS: Height & registration certificates / performance cards MUST be carried at ALL TIMES and produced on request of the steward or the rider will be disqualified from the competition (Entry fees, prize money and ribbons will be forfeited).

NOVICE HORSE/PONY: A Novice is a Horse/Pony which is yet to win 6 classes in any division at an A & P Show at the time of this Show. Once a horse/pony has six wins, it is not eligible for Novice Classes. Novices may enter Open classes. A novice horse/pony may be ridden by a rider of any age in Novice Pony Classes only. A Novice Champion may not compete in an Open Championship unless it has qualified through competing in an open class.

PLEASE NOTE: If insufficient entries, a class may be cancelled.

If the number of entries warrants it, a class may be split. Competitors to keep own list of classes entered.

Competitors ONLY in the ring during the Show - Disqualification will occur if this rule is not strictly adhered to. Times and locations in the Catalogue may differ from the Schedule depending upon Entries.

R.A.S. LEVY HAS BEEN INCLUDED IN ENTRY FEES.

PRIZE MONEY PAYOUT POLICY: For all Horse Sections:

1 Entry:1st Prize Money only2-4 Entries:1st & 2nd Prize Money only5+ Entries:Full Prize Money will be paidPrize Money may be substituted with product.

All entry fees & prize money are GST inclusive. PM \$5.00 and refunds \$20.00 and over will be paid out by direct credit using details on cheque with entry form after the show.

HORSE ACCOMMODATION:

Open Yards: \$14.00 per horse/pony for whole of Show Covered Yards & Boxes: \$25.00 per horse/pony for whole of Show PLEASE SPECIFY DAY/NIGHT ACCOMMODATION REQUIREMENTS CLEARLY ON ENTRY FORM.

COVERED HORSE ACCOMMODATION IS 25% OF TOTAL PENS AVAILABLE: Please

keep this in mind when ordering as there will be no refunds apart from those covered by the Scratching Clause. All horse accommodation will be allocated as fairly as possible on the basis of distance and early paid entries having preference, but people with large teams will have to be allocated some yards.

PLEASE NOTE WHEN BOOKING HORSE ACCOMMODATION:

Yards, covered yards & boxes will not be allocated until paid for. Please indicate if horses/ponies could share a large yard. Please note on Entry Form if horse/pony is an Entire, or any other special requirements. Horse Accommodation cannot be guaranteed to entries received after the closing date.

NO TEMPORARY FENCING ALLOWED & ABSOLUTELY NO TAPE.

CARAVAN SITES: are available at a cost of \$20.00 over the Show. Showers are available but no power at sites. Please reserve with entry if required.

PROCEEDS FROM THE GROUND LEVIES, ENTRY FEES AND HORSE ACCOMMODATION FEES ARE DIRECTED TOWARDS PRIZE MONEY, JUDGES ACCOMMODATION & CATERING FOR THE SHOW, HIRAGE OF EQUIPMENT, UPGRADING THE SHOWGROUND FACILITIES & RAS FEES.

AGES: In all breed classes, a foal is considered to have been born since 1 Aug 16; a yearling between 1 Aug 15 and 31 Jul 16; a two year old between 1 Aug 14 and 31 Jul 15 and a three year old between 1 Aug 13 and 31 Jul 14.



Show Jumping

*Please read & take note of the Horse Section – Rules, Regulations, Entries & Fees at the front of this Schedule.

Run under ESNZ Rules. All Registered horses must state their Registration Numbers on Entry Forms. Registration must be up-to-date.

Entry Fee total, horse accommodation, ground levies, etc, to be on Masterton A&P Association Entry Form.

ESNZ JUMPING AND CASUAL LEVIES

\$5 ESNZ Jumping Levy (Compulsory) – payable by all horses/ponies competing in Jumping and or Showhunter.

\$15 / \$10 Casual Jumping Levy

The rider must be a full member with ESNZ. Horse/Pony not registered for ESNZ J/SH can compete using this levy.

The levy is \$15 for the first day competing (this is related to the horse not the day of the show) and \$10 for subsequent days at the same show (shows may opt to combine the levies e.g. Competing one day only \$15 competing two days \$25).

Can jump up to 1.10 on a pony and up to 1.20 on a horse. Cannot compete in series classes and will not be eligible for HOY points in SH.

All classes are BLACKBOARD ORDER with the exception of Classes as indicated. Masterton A&P Show is a One Star Show
