No substitutions will be accepted after 1 week prior to show.

Dairy Section Exhibitors Points Prize – Breed Sections:

Dairy points will be calculated on the following basis:

In Milk - First – 10 points, second – 8 Points, third – 6 Points.

Dry Classes – First - 6 points, second – 4 points, third – 2 points

Championship 2 points and Reserve Champion 1 point in both classes.

Prize Money: 1st \$30 - 2nd \$20 - 3rd \$10 (Unless Sponsored)

Childrens Calf Classes - 1st \$15 - 2nd \$10 - 3rd \$5 - 4th \$2.00 - 5th Ribbon only - 6th Ribbon only.  
1 entry – Ribbon only (unless sponsored)

NB: Prize Vouchers must be handed in to the Chief Steward on show day to be redeemed.

All prize money will be paid out on the day. Prizes not claimed within two months of the show will be deemed invalid. No substitutions will be accepted after 1 week prior to show.

Rotorua A&P Members who are financial for the 2023/ year at the time of receiving this schedule may deduct 10% from their total entry fees as Member's discount.

Dress Standard for Cattle Rings – A tidy standard of dress is required.

All handlers are encouraged to wear Breed Colours. – Tidy closed in footwear (Leather or Vinyl is recommended). **NO Gumboots, Jandals or Sandals.**

It is a condition of entry to this show that owners entering cattle must sign the relevant Animal Status Declaration printed on the entry form and submit the Animal Declaration Certificate showing the whole herd or show cattle status with the entry form .

For Animals from a Movement Control Herd: The Owners will have to satisfy the requirements of the Movement Control Notice before animals can move to the Show.

Provided these requirements are met, The Animal Health Board cannot prevent these animals from being shown.

For Animals from a Declared Movement Control Area: All Show animals over the age of 3 months are to be tested with a negative test within 60 days prior to being moved to the Show.

The Rotorua A & P Association reserves the right to not accept such animals in the interest of other exhibitors.

For animals from all other areas: If the herd has a C3 status or better no Tb test is required provided the last whole herd test was within 12 months prior to the Show.

1.If the last whole herd test was not within 12 months of the Show, then Show cattle over 1 year old must have a clear test within the current show season.

2. If the herd has a status less than C3, then Show cattle over 1 year old must have a clear test within the current Show season.

3.All Cattle to be from EBL Neg / Free Herds.

4.All Cattle attending shows must wear the appropriate AHB tags.

5.Nait Requirements: A Nait approved RFID tag is mandatory for all movements of cattle, including calves. Please do not remove tags if cattle are identified with Animal Health Board or Minda tags. As of 1 July 2012 a secondary tag is no longer required under the new Nait scheme. All animals being exhibited at the Event come under the standard identification and ASD regulations, these cattle will require the Nait approved RFID tag. It is the exhibitors responsibility to record all animal movements with Nait 48 hours prior to leaving the farm/property for the Event and then within 48 hours of returning to the farm/property from the Event.

6. If an animal is not wearing it's allocated Number Tag it will not be allowed to enter the ring.

### **MALPRACTICE RULES**

DRUGS and FORBIDDEN SUBSTANCES means any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage, conformation or conduct of an animal by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardiovascular, repertory, alimentary, digestive, muscolskeletal or urogenital systems.

From the time any animal enters the show grounds or competes in any class or event the Society or its duly appointed Officer shall have the powers to order a drug test. An RAS Officer may order a drug test or examination for Malpractice at any time.

COMPLETE RULES MAY BE VIEWED AT THE SECRETARY'S OFFICE: **PLEASE NOTE:-**

1.No drugs to be administered onsite unless administered by a registered Veterinarian and notification to the Chief Steward.

This will be policed.

2. If an Exhibitor is uncertain of the rules and regulations of the Rotorua A&P Assn or the Royal Agricultural Society, they should contact the Secretary.

3. Dress Standard for Cattle Rings – A tidy standard of dress is required. All handlers are encouraged to wear Breed Colours.– Closed in footwear (Leather or Vinyl) is recommended.

**NO Gumboots, Jandals & Sandals.**

4. All pedigree cattle 1 year and over must be registered with the appropriate Breed Society

5. No bull or heifer under two years of age shall be eligible for Champion of Champions with the exception of the Beef Breeds.

6. Competitors disobeying the directions of the Stewards may be disqualified and forfeit all prize money.

7. Owing to the length of the programme competitors must be on hand for their Event. The Steward will call their name twice only. Entry fees will not be refunded if an Event is missed through not hearing the call.

8. Cups will be presented to winners and then retained by the A&P Assn to be displayed in Barclay House. The A&P Assn will engrave cups with the winner's name. A photographer will be available for photographing the winner and the cup if competitors should wish to have this done. Competitors will receive a rosette to commemorate their win.

9. All Beef Females (born before December 2022) be led by a halter and nose clip

10. All bulls 1yr and older must be nose rung and led in the ring by a person capable of controlling the animal. While transferring outside the ring ALL BULLS must have two handlers.

**11. NO ANIMALS TO BE ON SHOW GROUNDS BEFORE 10.00 am ON FRIDAY PRIOR TO THE SHOW.**

11a. Beef and Dexter Cattle must not be put into Cattle Pavilion or tied up in or near the Dairy Cattle Area until after 4.00pm on Sat. 2<sup>nd</sup> December. (Dairy Cattle Exhibiting Saturday – Beef Cattle Exhibiting Sunday)

12. ALL HORNED CATTLE MUST BE UNDER FULL SUPERVISION AT ALL TIMES WHETHER TETHERED OR ON A LEAD.

13. Any Cattle Class that have only 1 entry in the ring will be Ribbon Only (Unless sponsored)

14. A Breed Section constitutes a minimum of two Exhibitors and eight cattle .If numbers of entries are less, then the A&P Assn. Reserves the right to combine the section with another Breed or All Breeds Section.

15. All ages are stipulated June 1st of each year.

16.No exhibitors are to remove stock from the showground's before 2.45pm unless given special permission from the Chief Steward.

17. Nait Requirements: A Nait approved RFID tag is mandatory for all movements of cattle, including calves. Please do not remove tags if cattle are identified with Animal Health Board or Minda tags. As of 1 July 2012 a secondary tag is no longer required under the new Nait scheme. All animals being exhibited at the Event come under the standard identification and ASD regulations, these cattle will require the Nait approved RFID tag. It is the exhibitors responsibility to record all animal movements with Nait 48 hours prior to leaving the farm/property for the Event and then within 48 hours of returning to the farm/property from the event.

18. All dogs must be kept on a lead while on the Showground's.

19. It is the intention of the Rotorua A&P Assn to give winners names for publication.

20. NO SMOKING allowed in Cattle Show Rings or the Hutchings Cattle Pavilion.

21. Exhibitors must remove all unused Feed Stuff from Show Grounds at end of day. Leave Stand Tidy.

22. **ALL CATTLE HAVE TO BE TREATED FOR TICKS 5 DAYS PRIOR TO THE SHOW WITH A POUR ON. E.G:- BAYTICOL.**

### **PROTESTS:**

All protests must be in writing, and lodged with the Head Steward within 15 minutes of the class concerned being completed. The party entering a protest must deposit \$50 cash. This deposit will be returned if the protest is sustained. The Protest Committee will consist of the President, Chief Steward and the Section Leader of the ring concerned (or nominee) appointed by the A&P Assn. President.

### **DAIRY CATTTEL RULE CHANGES: NEW RULES AS OF 2015.**

The exhibiting of all Dairy Cattle in New Zealand is governed by the RAS Dairy Cattle Show Code of Ethics document. This document is Appendixes to the Additional Rules for Showing - Specific Sections. Other Dairy Cattle show conditions outside of the RAS Dairy Cattle Show Code of Ethics are listed below:-

A) All groups and cows in milk in the Dairy Breeds to be judged first.

B) All Dairy Bulls two years and over must be rung, have two leaders and under adequate supervision.

C) All Dairy Yearling Bulls must be rung and be under adequate supervision.

D) All cows three years of age and over, that have been tested and have production records printed on the entry forms have their production records printed in the catalogues.

E) No records are necessary for maiden three-year-olds.

F) Points in the dairy section will be awarded as follows:-

	In Milk	Dry Classes
1 <sup>st</sup>	10	6
2 <sup>nd</sup>	8	4
3 <sup>rd</sup>	6	2
4 <sup>th</sup>	4	1

Championship 2 points and Reserve Champion 1 point in both classes.

A \$5.75 Levy is to be charged per in-milk cow per show i.e. If an in-milk cow is entered in more than one class at a show then the levy is still \$5.75. There is no levy on exhibiting young stock.
