Equestrian and Cattle Camping Code of Conduct

It is a unique privilege that we are allowed to camp on the Showgrounds during the event, we must all work together to protect the opportunity to do so. Issues relating to antisocial behaviour, alcohol and security breaches may result in the permit being revoked. Please read carefully and acknowledge that by camping at the Show you agree to abide by this code of conduct.

Liquor

This is the first year the Society will hold the Liquor Licence for the event. To hold this licence, the event must comply with the local council rules and the District Licence Board. Any breach of these rules will result in no liquor licence being issued to the whole event.

Unfortunately as the Showgrounds and Pembroke Park are in an QLDC Alcohol-free Zone there can be no alcohol consumed outside of permitted licenced area (The Equestrian and cattle camping areas are not permitted licenced areas) ; the police therefore have the authority to prosecute.

NO BYO liquor is permitted

As a competitor, you will be issued a wristband which will permit you to enter the Club Members Area (The Rigby Club Rooms -Ring Side), this area is licenced 11-4.30pm after that please join us at the Show Bar until 8pm.

Anti-Social Behaviour

Please respect our neighbours, Show team, vendors, community and competitors. If you are staying in the equestrian/cattle camping area, please keep noise to an absolute minimum after 10pm and respect the onsite security personnel instructions. Instances of continuous disruption could result in a future Show ban.

Unauthorized Entry to Non-camping Area

No permitted campers can access the Showgrounds after 8pm except the area they are camping within. Equestrian and cattle campers should enter via gate 1 or 3 if returning out of hours and a wristband must be shown to enter.

Anyone seen climbing or entering via other fences/gates may be required to leave the grounds.

Toilets

If your vehicle is not self-contained, please remember to use the closest portaloos, these will be situated with camping areas if necessary.

NO GLASS

A reminder that we do not permit any glass on the Showgrounds including the camping areas. Please bring alternatives.
