EQUESTRIAN GENERAL RULES, REGULATIONS, ENTRIES & FEES AS WELL AS DANNEVIRKE & DISTRICTS A&P ASSOCIATION BY-LAWS AND REGULATIONS The show will be conducted under the Rules and Regulations issued by the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand (Inc) for the governance of the Dannevirke District Agricultural and Pastoral Association (Inc.).

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times, and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the showgrounds. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety, in Employment Act 2015.

Bikes, motorbikes, e-bikes etc are allowed in truck parking areas only. Helmets must be worn at all times when riding a bike.

All competitors riding horses or ponies must wear a riding helmet which has a current yellow tag.

Competitors and members of the public enter the grounds at their own risk.

CLEAN SPORT

The use of tranquilisers, stimulants, or any drug capable of affecting the performance of horses or ponies is forbidden. Competitors are advised that testsfor forbidden substances may be carried out during the show and that testing of all animals is at the owner's risk. Testing for forbidden substances will be carried out under the Royal Agriculture Society (Inc.), Clean Sport Judiciary Committee (CSJC) procedures and rules (refer Clean Sport Rules).

ENTRIES

- If insufficient entries, a class may be cancelled.
- The committee has the right to refuse an entry without explanation. If the number of entries warrant it, a class may be split.
- Competitors to keep own list of classes entered.
- Times in the Catalogue may differ from the Schedule depending upon Entries.
- Ground levy: \$10.00 per Horse/Pony for whole of Show: The Ground Levy must be paid by all competitors or entries will not be accepted.
- All fees can be paid online to 06-0613-0041542-02. Please include your details
- Entries close 26th January 2024: Late entries will be accepted until 31st January 2024 with a 50% penalty.
- All late entries and changes are to be done through Main-Events messaging under the show.
- Anyone with an outstanding balance will not be allowed to compete, including outstanding fees from the 2023 show.

ENTRIES DURING THE SHOW

Competitors will be able to place additional entries during the Show. This will apply only to animals that are already entered/competing at the Show. Additional entries will carry a 50% surcharge on the entry fee, which must be paid at the time the additional entry is made. These entries will then be processed, and updated sheets produced for Stewards for the next day's competition.

TRANSFERS

Competitors may transfer entered horse/pony to a different class under the following conditions:

- Transfers must be done at the Secretary's office or online with Main-Events with any difference in entry fees paid before the start of the class.
- If transferring to a class with a lower entry fee, the difference will be forfeited by the competitor
- No transfers will be accepted until paid in full.

SCRATCHINGS & REFUND OF ENTRY FEES

75% of entry fees only for the individual class will be refunded if notified by 5 pm 2nd February 2024. Scratchings from the entire show will receive a 75% refund of total entry only if accompanied by a Doctor/Vet/Farrier certificate, this must be received within 7 days of the show.

PRIZE MONEY/REFUNDS

All entry fees & prize money are GST inclusive.

- Prize money and refunds \$10.00 and over will be paid out by direct credit using details on entry form after the show.
- When paying entry fees by direct credit please ensure that your bank account details are included on your official entry form otherwise prize money and refunds cannot be paid.

ACCOMODATION & CAMPING

Competitor camping is free of charge Open yard: \$20 (whole show) Covered yards & boxes/stables: \$30 (whole show)

- Yards & boxes will not be allocated until paid for
- Please note on entry form if horse/pony is a stallion, or any other special requirements.
- Horse accommodation cannot be guaranteed to competitors who enter the official close of entries.
- Any stable/box/yard found to be in an unacceptable state at the conclusion of show will incur an additional cleaning fee of \$50.

ADDITIONAL NOTICES

- All competitors will receive a receipt of entries plus emailed gate passes for the show; it is your responsibility to have them with you.
- Please note that this is an A & P Show. There will be other livestock present in/near the Oval and horse classes will continue to run.
- Truck parking: As truck parking space is limited all trucks staying on the grounds must park as advised, close together and with no tying up of horses at trucks please tack up in your yard.
- No dogs on the grounds, owners will be eliminated

TROPHIES

This year we are reintroducing several trophies into circulation, all of which are perpetual trophies. Trophies are to be retained by the A&P.

- Castles Family Trophy: This trophy will be awarded to the winner of class 168 'Local Pony' and is open to any local pony rider, to be held at approximately 1.30 Sunday 4th Feb prior to the Saddle Hunter Pony class.
- PWJ Small Pony gaining most points across ring 2 jumping.

ESNZ JUMPING AND CASUAL LEVIES

The rider must be a full member with ESNZ unless competing at introductory level.

Casual jumpers can jump up to 1.00m on a pony and up to 1.10m on a horse and cannot compete in series classes and will not be eligible for HOY points in Show Hunter.

• \$7 ESNZ Jumping Levy (Compulsory) – payable by all horses/ponies competing in Jumping and or Show hunter.

- \$25 Casual Jumping Levy (for show) horse is currently registered with ESNZ but not for jumping (eg for eventing or dressage)
- \$30.15 Casual Jumping Levy (for show) horse is NOT registered with ESNZ
- \$16.30 per day Casual Membership riders may compete in Introductory class (80cm and under for ponies and 90cm and under for Horses) on an Introductory Membership or Casual Membership Day Start.

PLEASURE HORSE/PONY RING (HOYQ)

Pleasure horse/pony means that animals who do not fit the mould of a Show Horse/Pony.

We welcome any breed (e.g. appaloosas, quarter horses, standardbreds, Clyde X) and colour. They should be an uncomplicated and genuine pleasure to ride. Whilst they do not possess the show quality conformation of a show horse, they should in their own way be a delight to ride, with impeccable manners

A pleasure mount is not an inexperienced mount with show quality, conformation, who is destined for the open show ring. This section is aimed at competitive pleasure combinations.

This section is run in alignment with the rules and guidelines of the NZ Equestrian Pleasure Society (NZEPS). To see more information about what type of horse a pleasure horse is and what the NZ Equestrian Pleasure Horse Society is all about go to the website.

RULES:

If you enter this section you may not enter any other RAS Showing (excluding breed classes where competitors may compete) or the RECREATIONAL PLEASURE section at the Show. You can still enter show jumping and show hunter classes at the Show if you are ESNZ registered.

Simple snaffles only and no strapping below the bit, i.e. flash straps or drop nosebands. No spurs. Crops/whips allowed but not exceeding 76cm (i.e. No dressage whips)

Yellow tagged compliant helmets are compulsory. Plaiting and jackets are optional but preferred.

Rider 16 years old and under only in the pony classes, but riders 17 years and over may ride ponies in the horse classes.

Riders 16 years and under on a horse MUST ride with the adults in the Pleasure Horse classes.
