CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All entries to be printed on entry form enclosed.
- Entry fees must accompany the entry form otherwise the entry will not be accepted.
- Entry forms must be completed and signed personally by the exhibitor who will agree to comply with and submit to the rules of the show
- All entries entered in the Purebred & Partbred Welsh classes <u>MUST</u> be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of New Zealand (Inc.)
- In all classes where applicable the name of the pony, date of birth, sire and dam and Stud Book Number shall be given on the Entry Form.
- Purebred and Partbred Ponies & Cobs registered as geldings must be gelded with a Gelding Number
- The committee at its absolute discretion may refuse an entry or cancel any entry already accepted or decline to admit to the show grounds or remove any animal, exhibitor or person from the said grounds.
- 75% of Entry Fee which includes Stabling & Ground fees will be refunded on the presentation of a Doctors or Vets Certificate
- Foals under four weeks of age must not be exhibited.
- Foals to be led at all.
- The Judge's decision will be final.
- The committee reserves the right to amalgamate any class if less than 4 entries.
- The committee reserves the right to split classes if enough entries.
- All stables and yards must be left clean and tidy after use.
- All Colt Handlers must to be 16 years and over.
- All Handlers 13 years and under must wear an approved safety helmet when exhibiting in the ring
- All Handlers must be over 10 years of age at time of the show.
- All Dogs must be on lead at all times
- Registered Purebred Welsh Ponies/Cobs must not be plaited
- Registered Welsh Foals and Youngstock Purebred & Partbred are not to be clipped.
- Trimming is permissible, throat, lower jaw, jaw line. Trimming of Muzzle (whiskers) is not permitted.
- Youngstock are to be three years and under at date of show.
- The responsibility for accuracy of the description or pedigree and for the eligibility of animals to compete rests entirely with the exhibitor.
- All stallions and colts two years and over must wear a bit
- All stallions and colts one year and over must be stabled must not be tied to floats.
- The Committee at its absolute discretion may ask any exhibitor or person on the grounds who has been seem or reported abusing an animal will be immediately asked to leave the show. There will be no refund of Entry Fees.
- The Welfare of exhibits is paramount. No lame or sick animal to be bought into a class. ABUSE OF EXHIBITS: The welfare of exhibits is paramount. Any complaints of exhibit abuse will be dealt with by the committee. Abuse can be defined as intentionally acting in a way, which may cause pain or unnecessary discomfort to an animal. As examples, but not limited to; i. Whip or beat an exhibit excessively ii. Subject an exhibit to any kind of electric shock device iii. To jab the exhibit in the mouth with the bit. iv.. 'Rap' an exhibit anywhere in or outside the grounds of the event vi. Hyper sensitise any part of an exhibit vii. Leave exhibit without adequate food, drink and exercise.

- Under NZ Occupation Health & Safety it is the responsibility of **EVERYONE** on the grounds to ensure these rules are adhered to. The committee reserves the right to deal with anyone breaching these rules, which may include their removal from the grounds.
- The Committee reserves the right to make any alterations to the program or to postpone or cancel the day as it sees fit. Cancellation will be broadcast on Classic Hits at 8am. The committee will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused to or suffered by any exhibit, exhibitor or spectator, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the committee indemnified against any claim in respect of any such accident, loss or damage.
- □ ALL PERSONS AND THEIR PROPERTY ENTER THE GROUNDS AT THEIR OWN RISK.
 □ PROTESTS: All protests must be in writing and be lodged with the Secretary on the day within ten minutes and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$20.00 (Twenty dollars) which shall be refunded only if the protest is upheld. The decision of the protest committee shall be final.
