#### **General Rules**

Show General Rules to be read in conjunction with the Royal Agriculture Society Rules and Regulations.

After close off of entries, if there are less than five (5) animals and/or three (3) exhibitors entered in the classes/sections, the Committee may then amalgamate classes/sections as necessary.

#### **Entry**

- Entries to be submitted on online at <a href="https://www.main-events.com">www.main-events.com</a> or forward the official Entry Form & NAIT Entry form, signed and returned with payment.
- Entries close on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> November 2024. Late entries will be accepted, but will not be shown in catalogue and Show Gate entry will be required to be paid.
- Entry fee is \$15 per class per animal, unless stated, GST inclusive, a Tax Invoice/Receipt is available.
- For a Gate Entry Exhibitors will receive a 'One Adult One Day' ticket which will be taken from the person on the day of entry and a One Vehicle pass ticket. If enter late, no gate exhibitor gate ticket will be issued.

#### **Privacy Act**

The Association holds records of names, addresses, photographs and videos of members, exhibitors and exhibits including livestock and will publish these for the purpose of Show media reports or promotion.

#### **Health & Safety**

- All exhibitors accept the Association's conditions of entry and indemnify the Association under the provisions of the Health and Safety in Employment Act 2015 and subsequent amendments.
- Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable.
- Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate current animal legislation within NZ.
- The Association reserves the right to order immediate removal from the Showgrounds, of any animal it considers unruly or unmanageable.
- It is the Association's policy to see that all due care is taken to protect property.
- Persons occupying grandstands, buildings, other structures do so at their own risk, and no claim shall be made against the Association.
- Parking is entirely at the owners' own risk.
- > If you are leaving early on the Sunday you must tell the recorder (in the recorders box)

#### Protests / Behaviour & Conduct / Complaint

- In-Line RAS Resolution Process will be followed for all inappropriate behavior by exhibitor, competitor, member, official, spectator; exhibitor competitor rule breakage, animal abuse etc.
- The sanctions of YELLOW CARD for warning and RED CARD for penalty/expulsion will be used.
- > Every objection or protest must be made in writing, signed by the person making such complaint, and delivered to the Show Secretary.
- > The RAS 'In-Line Resolution Process' policy is available to view on the RAS website www.ras.org.nz .

#### Clean Sport

Any animal may be tested for Drugs or Forbidden Substances at any Show under the By-Laws and Regulations adopted by the Royal Agricultural Society.

#### **Prize Money**

All prize money will be paid out after the show into a nominated bank account, please enter details on the entry form. This will be done (subject to any queries) within 30 days of the final show day.

Points (Lloyd Putt Memorial Cup) 1<sup>st</sup> 50pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> 30pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> 10pts, 4<sup>th</sup> 5pts.

#### Disease Control T.B. Status [CATTLE AND DEER]

#### As per the current Biosecurity requirements:

All beef animals are to remain on the truck or trailer until they are scanned by a steward. If a tag is not recognized no animals are allowed to be unloaded and the exhibitor will be asked to leave the show grounds immediately

- All animals entered for showing or exhibiting must be from a current TB Clear Status Herd.
- > All animals entered for showing must be from a herd that is current with its TB testing requirements.
- The Association must be notified, within 48 hours, of any TB testing that results in potential TB issues being identified after entries have been submitted. This will include TB testing of animals associated with those entered for showing. Owners entering cattle must sign any declaration printed on the entry form.
- All animals entered, that originate from a movement control area, must be notified at the time of entry. These animals, if aged 90 days or older, must complete a clear pre-movement TB test within 60 days of their movement to the show.
- Animal Status Declaration Card. This is a legal requirement for all animals being moved. All animals entered must be accompanied in transit by a signed and dated Animal Status Declaration Card showing a Clear TB Status and required TB testing is complete.

- A NAIT approved RFID tag will be mandatory for all movements of cattle, including day old calves. NAIT approved RFID cattle tags are white only. Please do not remove tags if cattle are identified with TBFree New Zealand or MINDA tags.
- A secondary tag is no longer required under the new NAIT scheme.
- All animals being exhibited at the Show including any participating in a hoof and hooks carcass competition come under the standard identification and ASD regulations. These cattle will require the NAIT approved RFID tag.
- ➤ Where live cattle or deer form part of a trade display the exhibitor is responsible for:
  - o Ensuring all stock have completed all TB testing requirements as per TB Free New Zealand testing regulations.
  - o Ensuring all stock are identified in accordance with current legal requirements

#### **Beef Age Groups**

- Age of cattle to be calculated at 1 June 2024.
  - o Any bull born prior to 1 June 2022 must enter the bull 2 year and over class.
  - o Females born prior to 1 June 2022 must enter the Senior Cow class.
  - Females born between 1 June 2022 and 1 June 2022 must enter the 2 year old class.
  - Animals born between 1 June 2023 and 1 June 2024 must enter the yearling class.
  - o Animals born since 1 June 2024 are only eligible to enter calf classes.

#### **Beef General**

- > It is compulsory that all Beef Females (born before 31 December last) be led by a halter and nose clip.
- All led Bulls (born before 31 December last) must have a ring through the nose and be led by two leads and be under adequate supervision. Two Handlers are allowed with Senior Bulls whilst they are parading in the Show Ring.
- All bulls must be securely tied in stalls by an adequate chain around the neck or stout leather collar with an adequate rope attached, as well as a halter.
- If your animal is deemed unsafe (e.g. a danger to the general public) you may be asked by the chief steward to move your animal to a safe area. It will not be allowed to enter the ring. This decision is final.
- If insufficient numbers in any one class, classes will be combined at the discretion of the Beef Steward, who's decision will be final.
- Animals entering in the group classes must be entered in their eligible class.
- > There will be 3 calls for entrants into the class. If you miss these you will not be permitted entry to the ring.
- > Once ribbons are in hand, the placings are final.
- > Cattle tags numbers not returned by Exhibitor will be charged at \$5.00 each.
- At the conclusion of the show all exhibitors must remove all feed from the sheds.
- Sawdust will be used for bedding. NO straw allowed.
- Wash bay one breeder at a time using the wash bay, once finished the wash bay must be sterilized with Virkon (provided) before the next breeder can use the wash bay. **Sunday 8.00am to 8.45am wash bay for school calf use only.**
- It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to supply and must use R C D Units.
- All beef cattle must be on the grounds by 8.00am Saturday morning, and not leave before 3pm, and no cattle may leave until the completion of all classes on Sunday afternoon. Local competitors may remove calves and cattle they no longer require to show, but only calves will be permitted entry on Sunday.
- No Stud logos to be worn in the rings.




