- 3. Entry fees and other costs must accompany the entries otherwise the entry will not be accepted.

- 5. Entry must be completed by the Exhibitor or Person Responsible (18 years & over) who will agree to comply with & submit to the Rules of the show.
- 6. For any changes to entries, class changes or scratchings go to 'Messages' on main-events <u>Do Not</u> phone anyone on the committee!
- 7. Applications for Refunds must be in writing, accompanied by Drs/Veterinary Cert, & will be made after the Show at the Committees discretion. Maximum refund to be 80% of Entry Fee. Refunds apply only to horse/person for which Dr/Veterinary cert supplied.
- 8. All foals to be eligible for registration.
- 9. In all classes THE NAME OF THE HORSE/PONY must be entered, and where applicable the date of birth, sire, dam & stud book number shall be given on the entry. Foals registered as geldings must be gelded.
- 10. Foals under 3 weeks of age must not be exhibited.
- 11. When an animal has been entered & catalogued in any class the substitution of another animal will not be permitted.
- 12. Judging commences at 10.00am Entrants not present at commencement of class will not be admitted for judging.
- 13. The Judge's decision will be final.
- 14. The responsibility for accuracy of the description or pedigree and for the eligibility of animals to compete rests with the exhibitor.
- 15. The committee at its absolute discretion may refuse or cancel any entry already accepted; decline admission, or remove any animal, exhibitor or person from the grounds.
- 16. Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created; or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the show grounds. See Health & Safety Act 2015, and its amendments.
- 17. The committee will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused to or suffered by any animal, person or property.
- 18. The committee reserves the right to make any alterations to the program or postpone or cancel the show as it sees fit.
- 19. The committee reserves the right to amalgamate or divide any classes where necessary.
- 20. All stables must be left clean and tidy after use. Please place all soiled bedding at end of stable block where signposted.
- 21. No plaiting.
- 22. Whips in Led classes shall not exceed 120cm.
- 23. All Junior Handlers 10 Years & under MUST at all times have an Adult Supervisor who is not exhibiting in the same class.
- 24. DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH
- 25. Classes WILL NOT be delayed if the exhibitor has two classes running concurrently.
- 26. PROTESTS: All protests must be in writing and be lodged with the Secretary within 10 minutes & must be accompanied by deposit of \$50 which shall be refunded only if the protest is upheld.
- 27. The use of drugs capable of affecting the performance of exhibits is forbidden, and competitors are advised that testing for forbidden substances under the Royal Agricultural Society Forbidden Substance Judiciary Committee (FSJC) procedures and rules may be carried out during the show. Testing of all animals is at owner's risk.
- 28. Foals to have been born since 1st August 2024.
- 29. Yearlings to have been born since 1st August 2023.



- 30. Colts six months & over must wear a Bit & two 'S' bridle badges; handlers must wear official Stallion arm bands when in the ring; and a Hi Viz vest when not competing.
- 31. All colts must be under strict control at all times or you will be asked to leave the grounds. Handler must be 18 years and over
- 32. Exhibits must not be clipped, only trimming of legs, outer edge of ears and jaw allowed
- 33. All exhibitors need to provide their own number(s) which must be clearly visible either on the horse or the handler's arm (black no on white background) - no number, no start.
