## Please check your entries

Please check the emailed *Record of Entries* and your **bank account number**. This is the bank number we will use to direct credit any prize money or refunds. NO PHONE or FAX late entries or scratchings accepted. Email only.

#### Accounts must be settled!

Fees owing must be paid before you start.

There will be no refunds on stabling after the show and please settle your accounts within 7 days after the show or an administration fee may be charged.

## Keep up to date on entries at www.main-events.com

We are processing entries strictly in the order received. You will be given a customer code on the top of your record of entries which you can use to access your own rider page. The record of entries is emailed to you after we process entries. You enter the 3 letter 4 digit code in the MY CLASSES page under the show – this only appears if you are a registered user of <a href="https://www.main-events.com">www.main-events.com</a>.

Please check the emailed *Record of Entries* for any corrections – this makes the process quick and easy.

We should have the backlog of entries processed and up to date by Monday Dec 5th! It is your responsibility to check and make sure your entries have been processed by 5<sup>th</sup> Dec. If you arrive and we don't have entries, you will be a LATE entry.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### Is there a practise ring?

YES - there is a practice ring as we had last year.

## If you enter the university section of Class 2 Open Horse 1.30, can you enter the Great Lakes Challenge on the same horse?

No - The Great Lake Challenge conditions state that it is restricted to horses competing in 1.25 or less

#### Can I enter the Pony 6 Bar as a 3rd class on the same day?

YES – the Pony 6 Bar is considered a novelty class so the rule about only 2 starts a day for ponies does not apply to this class.

#### Can Junior/Pro Am riders compete in the Great Lake Challenge Open Horse class?

YES – while the Junior Rider and Pro Am class height jump is 1.20 to 1.30 and the condition for the Great Lake Challenge is that it is restricted to horses competing in 1.25 or less, the official height for ESNZ purposes is the average between the low and the high making it 1.25.

### Are Day registration or Casual Starts allowed?

NO - All classes at this show are above the height level for use of day registrations or casual starts. The ESNZ are now on a 1 day turnaround for memberships and registrations so there is **no** excuse not to have memberships and registrations up to date by the time the show starts. We should be able to verify your registration digitally with ESNZ records provided you registered before 2 Dec so we don't need to sight stickers.

#### Can I enter the Rookie Rider class on a different horse than I enter in the Young Rider class?

NO – the Rookie Rider class is a rider class. Therefore riders would **not** be eligible to ride in the Rookie Rider if they are competing in the Young Rider even if it is on a different horse.

#### Are dogs allowed on the grounds?

YES – but they must be on a lead at all times or there will be a \$50 fine. You must also have noted on your Stabling/Camping form that you are bringing dogs. Email us if you forgot. Dogs appear on your Record of Entries as an Other Fees & Receipts but with a zero value.

## Stabling/accommodation

Stabling is again being managed by Rupert Vallance from Main-Events.

Yards will have name label stickers. You are NOT to put your horse in any yard or stable if **your name** is not on it. If you have queries Rupert will be available to help you.

SCRATCHINGS! It is really important that you let us know of any scratchings immediately as we have a waiting list to get into the show. You are NOT to give your yards away to anyone else - they must go through the office.

## Writers and gate stewards needed

We have Tuwharetoa Polocross Club and Turangi Pony Club helping out as ring crews – but as always, if a rail drops and you are nearby please make an effort to put it up! And helping with course changes really speeds the day up!
