FROM THE SECRETARY

Tidy up done

Results have now been all entered. And jump sheets checked for late entries that did not go through the office or horses that were scratched but did appear on the jump sheets as competing. This is not to be tolerated and all such horses were charged 150% of the entry fee.

Now it is your turn to make sure you have the correct results and prize money associated with your horses under the RIDERS PAGE on Main-Events.com. Use the RIDER CODE as given to you by the show which appears on the top right of your original emailed Record of Entries. If you don't have it, then email and we will send it back to you. It is the first 3 letters of your last name and then the customer number – eg Jones would be JON1234.

In view of the weather, some riders left the show without first checking that they did not owe money. Unfortunately this has meant that a number of you should now be charged the \$25 admin fee as per the show conditions – but we will give you another week. All will be emailed with the balance owing and direct credit details for the show. If you do not finalise your account before the prize money is paid out to everyone else, you will be charged the \$25 admin fee to cover the costs involved with emailing, checking for deposits and repeat followups. That does make me grumpy ... and I will make a note of it on your customer record!

PM and Refunds payout

Prize money and refunds less any money you still owe for short paid items and late entries will be paid out the first week in January. You will be sent an email when it goes out. If you don't hear from us by mid January and think you should have money paid out, then please get back to us and we will check it out.

Cancellation policy for Sunday

The show organisers regrettably had to make the decision to cancel Sunday's competitions and as a gesture of good faith to those that stuck around to compete, we decided to refund all Sundays entry fees less 25% admin fee for that group. To be eligible for the refund you had to fill out a form at the office.

The main reason for the policy was that we had asked everyone to finalise their accounts prior to leaving the show as a means of reducing the admin work required following the show. Also when making the decision to cancel the final day of the show we were able to take note of the scratchings prior to Sunday in order to make our decision.

We appreciate that some had left but it had been made quite clear throughout that we require scratching forms to be filled out and accounts to be settled.
