EQUESTRIAN SECTION

Equestrian General Rules, Regulations, Entries & Fees Dannevirke A&P Association's District – Tararua Districts By-Laws & Regulations

The show will be conducted under the Rules & regulations issued by the RAS of NZ(Inc) for the governance of the Dannevirke District Agricultural and Pastoral Association (Inc). Competitors and members of the public enter the grounds at their own risk.

Special Rules – Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the showgrounds. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety, in Employment Act 1992.

All competitors riding horses and ponies must wear a hard hat or jumping helmet.

DOGS – NO DOGS ARE TO BE BROUGHT ONTO THE SHOWGROUNDS, UNLESS THEY ARE COMPETING AT THE SHOW

Forbidden Substances – The use of tranquillsers, stimulants, or any drug capable of effecting the performance of horses and ponies is forbidden. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the show and that testing of all animals is at the owners risk. Testing for the forbidden substances will be carried out under the RAS (Inc) Forbidden Substance Judiciary (FSJC) procedures and rules

ENTRY FORMS – Entry Forms must clearly state the class number, name and address of entrant, name of horse/pony, name of exhibitor/rider at time of entry. Official Entry Forms must be used and stickers attached where appropriate for the ESNZ registered Classes/Competitions etc. **All fees can be paid on line to – 060613-0041542-02**

ENTRIES WHICH DO NOT COMPLY AND ARE NOT PAID IN FULL WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

<u>Height Certificates and Performance Cards must be carried at all times and</u> <u>produced on request. Failure to do so will result in elimination</u>

ENTRIES DURING THE SHOW – Competitors will be able to place additional entries during the course of the Show. This will apply only to animals that are already entered/competing at the Show. Additional entries will carry a 50% surcharge on the entry fee, which must be paid at the time the additional entry is made. These entries can only be made at the main Secretary's Office before 5 p.m on the day preceding the competition. These entries will then be processed and updated sheets produced for Stewards for the next day's competition.

SHOW JUMPING TRANSFERS

Competitors may transfer an entered horse/pony to a different class under the following conditions -

- Transfer form completed and fee of \$2 per transfer plus entry fee difference paid at the Horse Secretary's Office
- Transfers must be notified at least 1 hour before the start of the class you are transferring to.
- Transferred entries will be the first to jump.
- No transfers will be accepted until paid in full.

ENTRY OF SUBSTITUTIONS

- 1. The substitute must be of the same height as the original entry.
- 2. Vet certificate not required
- 3. Substitution must be lodged in writing with the Secretary in time to avoid disruption of the smooth running of the show.
- 4. Substitution forms available at the Secretarys Office

SCRATCHING & REFUND OF ENTRY FEES

80% of Entry Fees will be refunded for scratchings ONLY if notified in writing at least 1 hour before the start of the class.

ANYONE WITH OUTSTANDING BALANCES MAY NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE

All entry fees & prize money are GST inclusive

PM and refunds \$5 and over will be paid out by direct credit using details on cheque with entry form after the show.


