

RULES, REGULATIONS, ENTRIES & FEES Friday 17th, Saturday 18th & Sunday 19th February 2012 Solway Showgrounds, Judds Road, Masterton

CHIEF HORSE MARSHALL: Ms Christine Rowe DEPUTY: Mr Toby Blundell

THE HORSE SECRETARY'S OFFICE: Situated under the Judges Box on the Eastern side of the Solway Oval (opposite the Grandstand). Open during the show for all Horse Section enquiries, transfers, etc.

RULES: Copies of Rules and Regulations are available on application and all entries are accepted on the clear understanding that the rules will be adhered to. The Judge or person nominated by the Committee may demand the production of performance cards or other proof that the horse/pony is currently registered (when registration is obligatory Rule 30 NZEF). For hack and pony competitions a valid RAS Height Certificate is to be produced when required.

FORBIDDEN SUBSTANCES: The use of tranquilisers, stimulants, or any drug capable of effecting the performance of horses or ponies is forbidden. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the show and that testing of all animals is at the owners risk. Testing for forbidden substances will be carried out under the Royal Agriculture Society (Inc.), Forbidden Substance Judiciary Committee (FSJC) procedures and rules (refer Rule 10 RAS By-laws and Regulation Section 55A).

YELLOW CARD SYSTEM: This show supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system, which will operate in the Equestrian Section of all RAS affiliated Shows and will be offered for any inappropriate behavior towards Show Officials, Judges, fellow competitors or any third party connected with the Show brining the equestrian discipline into disrepute, or cases which are of a less serious nature to the above in accordance with the Conduct of Members, Owners, Lessees, Competitors and/or Exhibitors as provide in the RAS Equestrian Competitors and Judges Rulebook and rule 13 of the RAS Constitution." Implementation of the 'Yellow Card' will be in accordance of the RAS Rules that accompanied this card, and full wording of the 'Yellow Card' system is available to view of the RAS website.

PLEASE NOTE: Each Exhibitor must supervise their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created, accidents, illness or damage caused by the actions of themselves or their animals at the Solway Showgrounds. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1993.

HORSES OR PONIES LOOSE ON THE GROUNDS WILL BE IMPOUNDED.

DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE OVALS AND MUST BE ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES.



PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: A hard hat is generally described as a hunting cap, a bowler, protective headwear or a safety helmet. Wearing of a hard hat is compulsory for anyone competing on, working in or schooling, or riding, or for any other reason, a horse/pony at an A&P Show or in any area considered to be for whatever reason, a part of the Showgrounds. All riders 16 years and under must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chin strap properly adjusted and fastened when mounted within the Showgrounds.

PROTESTS: Protests must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of class being completed with a fee of \$50.00 which will be refunded only if protest is upheld.

ABUSE OF SHOW OFFICIALS WILL RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION, AS WILL PARKING IN NON-DESIGNATED AREAS. CUTTING AND DRESSAGE WHIPS ALLOWED ONLY IN DRESSAGE SECTION.

PLEASE CHECK YOUR TROPHIES THOROUGHLY AND RETURN THOSE THAT ARE THE PROPERTY OF MASTERTON A & P SHOW IN CLEAN CONDITION AT, OR BEFORE, SHOWTIME - THANK YOU.

ENTRIES: ENTRIES CLOSE WEDNESDAY 01st FEBRUARY 2012:

THE ASSOCIATION HAS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY ENTRY MASTERTON A&P ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP FEE: \$35.00

ENTRY FORMS: Entry Forms must clearly state the class number, name and address of entrant, name of horse/pony, name of exhibitor/rider at time of entry. Official NZEF Entry Forms must be used and stickers attached where appropriate for NZEF Registered Classes/Competitors, etc. ENTRIES WHICH DO NOT COMPLY AND ARE NOT PAID IN FULL WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

LATE ENTRIES: A late entry is defined as an animal not officially entered (on the Entry Form) in the Show by the closing date specified in the Schedule. Late entries are accepted with a 50% penalty.

ENTRIES DURING THE SHOW: Competitors will be able to place additional entries during the course of the Show. This will apply only to animals that are already entered/competing at the Show. Additional entries will carry a 50% surcharge on the entry fee, which must be paid at the time the additional entry is made. These entries can only be made at the Secretary's Office up to 1hr preceding the competition. These entries will then be processed and updated sheets produced for Stewards for the competition. There will be no exception or variance to these details.

SHOWJUMPING TRANSFERS: Competitors may transfer an entered horse/pony to a different class under the following conditions:

Transfer form completed and fee of \$2.00 per transfer plus entry fee difference paid at the Horse Secretary's office. Transfers must be notified at least one hour before the start of the class you are transferring to. Transferred entries will be the first to jump.



ENTRY OF SUBSTITUTIONS: Horse/Pony may be substituted only into original class, and must be property of the same person as the original entry.

SCRATCHINGS & REFUND OF ENTRY FEES: 25% of Entry Fees will be refunded for scratchings ONLY if notified in writing the day before the class is to be run.

THERE ARE NO REFUNDS FOR ANY SUM UNDER \$20.00.

HEIGHT/PERFORMACE CARDS: Height & registration certificates / performance cards MUST be carried at ALL TIMES and produced on request of the steward or the rider will be disqualified from the competition (Entry fees, prize money and ribbons will be forfeited).

STALLIONS: All Stallions MUST at all times wear stallion badges.

NOVICE HORSE/PONY: A Novice is a Horse/Pony which is yet to win 6 classes in any division at an A & P Show at the time of this Show. Once a horse/pony has six wins, it is not eligible for Novice Classes. Novices may enter Open classes. A novice horse/pony may be ridden by a rider of any age in Novice Pony Classes only. A Novice Champion may not compete in an Open Championship unless it has qualified through competing in an open class.

PLEASE NOTE: If insufficient entries, a class may be cancelled.

If the number of entries warrants it, a class may be split. Competitors to keep own list of classes entered.

Competitors ONLY in the ring during the Show - Disqualification will occur if this rule is not strictly adhered to. Times and locations in the Catalogue may differ from the Schedule depending upon Entries.

R.A.S. FORBIDDEN SUBSTANCE TESTING LEVY HAS BEEN INCLUDED IN ENTRY FEES.

Show Hunter Classes

CONDITIONS AND DEFINITIONS:

- 1. Appropriate classes qualify for HOY 2012 and NZ Hi Points and Equitation series classes.
- 2. For registered classes all horses/ponies must be registered with ESNZ and entry must be accompanied by an ESNZ horse/pony sticker. For training/Childrens classes, an unregistered rider may compete by paying \$5 per day membership and an unregistered horse/pony may compete by paying \$5 per day registration.
- 3. Training and Open Hunter: Open to any horse regardless of experience.
- 4. Junior Hunter: Open to riders under 21 years on horses open to all horses.
- 5. Amateur: Open to riders 21 years and over, not to have competed in showjumping at a height higher than 1.25m or to have competed in Advanced level horse trials in the current or preceding ESNZ show season which runs from 1st August to 31st July.
- 6. First Year Registration. Open to all horses and ponies in their first year of recognised Show Hunter competition. A horse/pony may remain 1st year registered until 12 months after it gains ONE point in any qualifying recognised Show Hunter Class. The horse/pony is considered to have started it's first year on the day it gains its initial point and may remain in First Year Registration for 365 days starting on that date, and thereafter becomes Open. Open
- horses/ponies may not enter 1st yr classes, but 1st yr horses/ponies may enter open classes.7. Ponies may enter any category with the exception of the EIT Pony High Points class
- 7. Ponies may enter any category with the exception of the EIT Pony High Points class where ponies may only enter the correct height related category.


