NOTE: TUBERCULOSIS AND BRUCELLOSIS TESTING FOR ALL BREEDS:

All cattle 3 months of age and over entered for a Show **MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A SIGNED AND DATED TB DECLARATION CARD.**

The animals must have:

Either a TB Free or an Accredited TB Free status, and in the case of breeding stock, be Accredited Brucellosis Free.

DECLARED TB MOVEMENT CONTROLLED AREAS: Cattle 3 months of age and over which are farmed or grazed within a Declared TB Movement Controlled Area must be negative to a TB test within 12 months prior to the start date of the Show.

All Other Areas: Cattle 12 months of age and over, farmed or grazed outside of the Declared Movement Control Areas must be negative to a TB test within 12 months prior to the start date of the Show.

Under the Biosecurity (Animal Identification Systems) Regulations 1999, cattle may be moved to a Show without official primary or secondary ear tags provided that:

1. The animals are moved directly to and from the place of the Show under the direct control of the owner.
2. The animals carry a mark registered to a breed society.
3. A permit to move the animals without official ear tags has been issued by AgriQuality New Zealand.

TB Trucking cards must accompany animals.

TB DECLARATION CARDS MUST BE WITH THE SHOW SECRETARY 48 HOURS PRIOR TO SHOW DAY.
