Health and Safety

All Exhibitors must comply with the requirements of the Health and Safety Act (1992).

All practical steps must be taken by exhibitors to ensure the safety of their staff and the public. Exhibitors must submit a list of identified hazards posed on their site, along with remedies to eliminate, isolate or minimise these. Forms will be provided with the Exhibitor Manual to assist with this.

All exhibitors and contractors working on site need to familiarise themselves with the Health and Safety procedures of the venue, these are available from Mystery Creek Events Centre Reception.

Power Requirements

Inside Sites

All inside sites will receive a standard single phase 10 amp power point and a 4-way multi-box. To order additional power, please contact the Equidays Event Executive.

Outside sites

All outdoor sites will receive a standard 16 amp power point. Exhibitors can also request a 4-way multi-box. All outside exhibitors must supply their own 25 metre extension cord.

Additional single phase power points can be supplied at \$180 + GST per point. 32 amp three phase connections (96amps) can be supplied at \$760 + GST.

Security

Uniformed security guards will be onsite from 8am Tuesday 15 November until 5pm Monday 21 November 2011. While all reasonable security and safety precautions are taken by Mystery Creek Events Centre, there will be no responsibility taken for loss or damage to exhibitors' property whilst at Mystery Creek Events Centre.

Sharing a Site (Subletting)

Subletting is when an exhibitor (primary) invites another exhibitor (secondary) to display or demonstrate their secondary products or services on the primary exhibitor's site.

Equidays has strict rules regarding subletting. The subletting (secondary) exhibitor must:

- · Be eligible to exhibit at Equidays
- Complete and sign an application form, and pay the sublet fee of \$350.00 (+ GST).
- · Complete a Health and Safety form identifying hazards

If the subletting company fails to submit a site application form and pay the fee, their exhibit will be closed down and they will be asked to leave.

The subletting (secondary) exhibitor will have a separate programme listing, a separate website company listing, and their own ticket allocation. Please contact the Equidays Event Executive with any sublet queries.

In order to be part of the early bird allocation, please return your Site Application form and deposit to us by **20 May 2011**. If more than one application is received for a particular exhibition site, a ballot will be held.

1.0 General

Equidays acting through the appointed officer shall be sole judge of whether the following items have been adhered to in a proper manner. The decision of Equidays shall in all respects be final and conclusive. If, in the opinion of the organisers, a serious breach of these terms and conditions has taken place, an exhibitor may be required to remove their exhibit within 24 hours of notice being given. In such a case all fees paid or due to Equidays shall be forfeit. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Prospectus, the organisers reserve the unrestricted right to make such rules or orders for the proper conduct of the exhibitors, as circumstances may warrant, either before or during the currency of the exhibition.

2.0 Application for Exhibition Site

- 2.1 All applications for exhibition sites should be made promptly on the application form and returned to this office with the required deposit. The balance payment of the total site fee is due by 01 July 2011. If for any reason the exhibitor fails to make any of the nominated payments by the due dates, Equidays may at their discretion, proceed to re-let the site without being liable to account to the exhibitor for any sum already paid or due from them. The exhibitor will continue to be contractually liable for any outstanding funds.
- 2.2 Site and additional service fees must be paid in full before site occupation and ticket allocation. Any unpaid site or additional service fees will attract 10% interest per month on the full amount outstanding and any collection fee if required.
- 2.3 Equidays reserves the right to allocate sites, but where possible will endeavour to meet applicant's requests. Allocation will be made by an Equidays appointed officer who will give regard to the order in which applications are made and has the right to refuse entry and decline applications.
- 2.4 The site plan shown in the Prospectus is indicative and may be altered depending on sales. Organisers reserve the right to alter the site plan if considered necessary.
- 2.5 A high standard of display is required. The exhibitor shall not permit any other company to share any part of their exhibition site unless subletting (refer Clause 3 – Subletting).
- 2.6 Only NEW equine products shall be displayed and sold on the exhibition site at Equidays.

3.0 Subletting

If a company normally sells a particular product line it may continue to do so providing they use their own staff and it clearly appears that the product is integrated into the exhibitors' site. If an exhibitor applies for site space and invites another company to exhibit on their site the secondary exhibitor must pay a sublet fee of \$350.00 (excluding GST) to Equidays and must fill in a separate application form.

4.0 Liability

If for any reason the exhibitor does not make any of the payments hereunder on the due date, the organiser may at their discretion, proceed to re-let the site without being liable to account to the exhibitor for any sum already paid or due from them without prejudice to the organiser.

5.0 Cooperation

No exhibitors shall permit their exhibition stand to be used in such a manner as to conflict with the purpose of the exhibition or the rights of other exhibitors. In the event of any dispute arising between exhibitors, in relation to the exhibition such disputes shall be submitted to the organisers in writing for consideration, and the decision of the organisers shall be accepted by all parties as final and conclusive in all respects.

6.0 Cancellation of Contract

- 6.1 If an exhibitor should cancel the contract or terminate a site booking:
 - (a) prior to 01 July 2011 any refund shall be at Equidays' discretion, notwithstanding that a portion shall be retained to defray expenses/costs.
 - (b) On or after 01 July 2010 Equidays shall retain all monies received.

- 6.2 Equidays has the right to cancel this contract and to retain any monies paid in relation to this contract if the Exhibitor:
 - (a) infringes any of the Exhibiting Conditions and/or
 - (b) does not occupy the site during the full period of the Equidays to which this contract applies and/or
 - (c) does not occupy the site by 5pm on the day preceding the opening day of Equidays.

7.0 Cancellation of Equidays

- 7.1 If Equidays is cancelled by the organiser, cancellation will be confirmed in writing, and rental monies paid (inclusive of deposit) will be returned in full.
- 7.2 If an exhibitor cancels a booking for a site/sites, cancellation must be confirmed in writing, and fees paid to date will be forfeited.
- 7.3 The organisers will not be liable for any additional compensation if Equidays is cancelled.

8.0 Show Closure

Exhibitors should not begin removing their exhibition and must be available to customers/visitors until closing time on the last day of the show, 5pm Sunday 20 November 2011.

9.0 Utility Service Charges

Extra lights and power points on display sites can only be supplied by the organiser's electrician on application and at the exhibitor's expense.

10.0 Theft, Damage or Loss

It is expressly stated that under no circumstances will Equidays accept any responsibility whatsoever for any loss, damage or theft to any exhibitors stand, property or equipment by any cause or means whatsoever. Exhibitors are required to provide supervision during the whole time that the exhibition is open to the public. It is requested that all exhibits, fixtures, fittings, equipment etc shall be adequately insured against any claims in relation to allocation of space and the actions and conduct of employees. The exhibitor should hold appropriate public liability insurance at a recommended level no less than \$3 million (three million dollars), however this does not in any way suggest liability is limited to this level for any loss or damage caused by your negligence. We suggest you discuss this with your insurance broker/advisor to ensure you are sufficiently insured.

11.0 Advertising

Exhibitors shall have the full right to advertise within the confines of their own stand, but Equidays reserves the right to prohibit any such advertising material or equipments which obstruct aisles/roads, interferes with or obstructs neighbouring stands or is, in the opinion of the organisers, a source of annoyance to others. No exhibitor, or employee thereof including promotional staff, may canvas other than from within the boundaries of their own exhibition site. Advertising and promotion in car parks on site is prohibited.

12.0 Noise

If exhibitors intend to use amplifiers and loud speakers on their exhibition site, prior written approval must be obtained from Equidays. The organisers reserve the right to withdraw such approval if use of such equipment proves disruptive to other exhibitors.

13.0 Legal Requirements

Notwithstanding anything contained in any part of these terms and conditions, it shall be the express responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure that their exhibit complies in all respects with such legal and local government requirements as may be in force at the time of the exhibition. All exhibitors must comply with all provisions of the Health & Safety in Employment Act (1992).

14.0 Competitions or Contests

Exhibitors desiring to run any form of competition must gain prior written approval from Equidays. Competitions or contests must be free of charge to patrons. No raffles or fund raising shall be run.

15.0 Radio and Electronic Devices

The use of radio, public address systems or other electronic devices within the exhibit sites that affect the display of the exhibitor's products or trade process, will be permitted subject to, in each

EXHIBITING CONDITIONS

instance, approval from Equidays. This regulation is not designed to discourage the use of such appliance but to ensure that they are adjusted so as not to operate to the discomfort of other exhibitors or public. Plans for their use should be submitted for prior written approval, and such use will be subject to regulation during the show.

16.0 Power Cables

For outside exhibitors, underground power cables will be marked with red paint on the grounds. Absolutely no digging or tent pegs shall be permitted in the power cable area.

DANGER - NO DIGGING BETWEEN THE RED LINES.

17.0 Selling of Food and Beverage

Exhibitors are not permitted to distribute food or beverages from their exhibition site without prior written approval from Equidays. Only approved food distributors will be permitted to sell food in designated food areas for the duration of the event. Such food distributors must comply with all legal and local authority regulations in order to handle, prepare, sell or display food. Food distributors may be required to install sink and hot water systems. Consent on this matter should be obtained from the Health Division of the Waipa District Council.

18.0 Alcohol

To comply with our liquor license, exhibitors are not permitted to bring alcohol onto the site, nor give away, sell or distribute alcoholic beverages for cash or for vouchers.

19.0 Fire Retardant Materials

In compliance with the NZ Building Code (C3/ASI Table 4) exhibitors are informed that curtains, drapes or backdrops are to be restricted to Fire Retardant Materials with a flammability index no greater that 12. Further information may be obtained from the Building Inspectors Department, Waipa District Council.

20.0 Security

Equidays will have security guards on site from 8am Tuesday 15 November 2011, remaining on site until 5pm Monday 21 November 2011. Exhibitors shall not rely on the security guards for the security of their products. Exhibitors shall make certain they are sufficiently insured for sole risk.

21.0 Removal

All displays must be removed from the Mystery Creek Events Centre site by 5pm Wednesday 23 November 2011, unless alternative arrangements have been made with the organisers. If any property/displays remain on the site after the break down period, Equidays organisers will arrange for the removal of such items, at the exhibitors' expense. Exhibitors will be responsible for ensuring their site is left in its original condition. Failure to do so will result in the exhibitor having to pay for the re-instalment of the exhibition site, and a fee of \$100 (+GST) per day. Exhibitors shall at all times be responsible for their property and have appropriate insurance.

22.0 Vehicles

All vehicles must be removed from the exhibition site, and parked in the car park, by 9.45am each morning. Vehicles remaining on the exhibition site after 9.45am will be removed at the exhibitor's expense. Vehicles will not be permitted into the show area while the show is open to the public without the written permission of the organisers.

23.0 Amendments

The organisers and promoters of Equidays reserve the right to amend any part or parts of the herein described.

24.0 Consequential Loss

Equidays shall not be liable for any consequential loss which may arise out of any association with Equidays.

25.0 Fire Extinguishers

Fire extinguishers MUST be held on each exhibitor's site. This is the exhibitors' responsibility.

26.0 Photographic Rights

Commercial photographers and media must apply for Equidays Media Accreditation. Photography (still and video) taken by representatives of Equidays during the event will remain the property of the organisers and may be used for promotional purposes. Any exhibitor who wishes to be excluded from being photographed must advise the Equidays Event Executive in writing at least one week prior to the event opening.

27.0 Young Persons on Site

- 27.1 A condition of entry to Mystery Creek is that all activities must comply with the Health and Safety in Employment Act of 1992 and Health and Safety in Employment Regulations 1995 (SR 1995/167) (as at 01 April 2009) which deals specifically with the presence of young persons on site during set up times:
 - (a) no person under the age of 15 years shall be present in any area at the place of work:
 - (b) at any time when goods are being prepared or manufactured for trade or sale in that area;
 - (c) at any time when any construction work is being carried out in that area (set up and breakdown times);
 - (d) at any time when any logging operation or tree felling operation is being carried out in that area;
 - (e) at any time when any work is being carried out in that area that is likely to cause harm to the Health and Safety of a person under the age of 15 years.
- 27.2 Persons under 15 years of age can be present on site when:
 - (a) under the direct supervision of an adult in that area; or
 - (b) on a guided tour of that area; or
 - (c) in any office in that area; or
 - (d) in any part of that area used only for selling goods or services.
- 27.3 If young persons are going to be present on site under any of the above clauses this must be noted on your hazard register complete with a plan on how they will be supervised. This plan must be signed off by the Facilities and Property Manager before the children are bought to site.

28.0 Health and Safety

A Hazard Identity form must be completed and submitted to the Equidays office, prior to site set up. Forms are available online or from the Equidays Event Executive.
