




Organic Farm Tour

EQUESTRIAN EVENTS

RULES AND CONDITIONS

Entries close either by hand or through the mail on Wednesday 9th January 2013 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: That the entry is in the Secretary's hands no later than 4pm Thursday 24th January 2013. Entries postmarked later than 5pm on 8th January 2013 will incur a 50% penalty. Late entries will not be processed unless the penalty is included in the payment. Show Hunter Competitors — please read "Conditions for Show Hunter Entries" at beginning of your schedule..

- 1. No entries will be acknowledged unless accompanied by fees.
- 2. Run under the By Laws and Regulations of the RAS and or Local Conditions as designated.
- 3. Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the show grounds. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the HEALTH AND SAFETY EMPLOYMENT ACT 1993.
- 4. The Rotorua A&P Assn is an affiliated A&P Show to the RAS of NZ Inc. and as such, the use of tranquillizers, stimulants, or any drugs capable of affecting the performance of horses and ponies is forbidden.
- 5. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and that testing of all animals is at the owner's risk. Testing for forbidden substances will be carried out under the Royal Agricultural Society Forbidden Substance Judicial Committee (FSJC) procedures and rules (refer rule 97 RAS Equestrian Judges and Competitors Rule Book and rule 55a of the RAS General Rules and Regulations)
- 6. This Show supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system, which operates in the Equestrian Section of all RAS affiliated Shows and will be offered for any inappropriate behaviour towards Show officials, Judges, fellow competitors or any other third party connected with the Show bringing the equestrian discipline into disrepute, or cases which are of a less serious nature to the above in accordance with the Conduct of Members, Owners, Lessees, Competitors and/or Exhibitors as provided in the RAS Equestrian Competitors and Judges Rulebook and rule 13 of the RAS Constitution. Implementation of the "Yellow Card" will be in accordance of the RAS Rules that accompanied this Card, and full wording of the "Yellow Card" system is available to view on the RAS website.
- 7. No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions or any other Show charge is eligible to compete at any A&P Show. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction will be lifted.
- 8. The Rotorua A&P Assn Show Committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without adducing any reason for so doing.
- 9. No substitutions of any entries are permitted. Horses and Ponies that qualify for Champion or Supreme Classes must be ridden by the same Rider in which it qualified.
- 10. Cups/Trophies will be presented to the winners and then retained by the Assn. to be displayed in Barclay House. The A&P Assn will engrave cups/trophies with the winner's name. A photographer will be available if required.
- 11. Except in rider classes, every animal must be named.
- 12. A Novice pony or rider is one that has yet to win six classes in any division within the competitions provided at any A & P Show. Novice animals are eligible for open classes.
- 13. Novice ponies may be ridden by riders of any age.
- 14. In all jumping events, a skullcap must be worn. NB: All riders 16 years and under must wear headgear which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area, collecting rings or anywhere else within the

showground's.

- 15. No dressage type whips are allowed in ridden classes. Refer RAS rule.
- 16. The measuring rules of the RAS of NZ will apply at this show. All entries (Hacks, Ponies and Miniature Horses) entered in any height classes must have a current height certificate. If Height Certificate not able to be produced on request No start permitted.
- 17. Starting times are approximate only, but will be adhered to as closely as possible. Although it is provided that horses may compete in more than one class, any or all of such classes may be judged simultaneously at the convenience of the Judges or Stewards, in all such cases exhibitors having an exhibit entered in more than one class must elect in which class they compete. The Steward will call their name twice only.

Entry fees will not be refunded if an event is missed through not hearing the call.

- 18. It is the intention of the Rotorua A&P Assn to give winners names for publication in the local newspaper.
- 19. A ground levy of \$10.00 per horse/pony (Competing in Rings 1 7) will be charged to each competitor. This is indicated on the entry form. Show Hunter entries see Conditions for Show Hunter Entries above your schedule.
- 20. Scratchings: Refund of entry fees will be considered if scratchings are made in writing officially with the Secretary by Tuesday prior to the show. Refunds will be less 25% of the original entry fee. Veterinarian/Doctors certificate is required for scratchings during the show. Refunds are at the discretion of the Show Committee.
- 21. All competitors must park their floats and trucks in the area designated for this purpose. NO EXCEPTIONS. All Hack and Pony competitors are to enter via Stembridge Road entrance. (Refer to map) Some hack competitors may be directed to the Western Road parking area. Those camping will be given preference.
- 22. Application for pens must be made and paid for with entries. Pens are \$10.00 per horse for show.
- 23. All exhibitors in Rings 1-7 and Show Hunter Rings will be issued with a back number. Breastplate number holders will be allowed.
- 24. All dogs must be kept on a leash while on the showground's under penalty of elimination.
- 25. Financial Members of the Rotorua A&P Assn for 2012/2013 year may deduct 10% from their total entry fees as member's discount.
- 26. All prize money will be paid by cheque within three weeks any queries must be lodged within six weeks of the shows completion. Prizes not claimed within two months of the show will be deemed invalid. The Committee reserves the right to substitute product for prize money.
- 27. Novice Performance Cards: It is the responsibility of the owner/rider to present these to the Horse/Pony Ring Office for updating. No Card No Ring Entry No Placing No Prize Money 28. Sponsors product may be presented in lieu of prize money.
- 29. Protests:

All protests must be in writing and be entered within 30 minutes of the class being completed. The party entering the protest must deposit \$50.00 cash. This deposit will be refunded if the protest is sustained. The protest committee will consist of the Ring Steward of the ring concerned and the Head Steward (Hack or Pony) of the ring concerned.

- 30. Prize Money
- 5 entries no 3rd prize money
- 4 entries no 2nd prize money
- 3 entries or less, 1st prize money only.

The object of these competitions is to encourage riders to turn out a first class mount with good gear and raise the standard of dress of riders at Agricultural & Pastoral Shows. –

In the event of equality of placings, the classification shall be decided by adding together the points awarded for manners & paces and riding ability. If there is still equality, points for conformation shall decide the classification. After that the combination of unity points will be considered, then costume, then saddlery.
