1. Entries close and must be received no later than **5pm Tuesday 5th February 2013**
2. Please make cheques payable to 'The Horse of the Year'
3. Entry Fees are \$25 per class - all other fees as per HOY schedule
4. All Para-Equestrian entries must be submitted on an official 2013 New Zealand Horse of the Year entry form plus an ESNZ entry form (signed) on which no entries for other disciplines are included and a 2013 Para-Equestrian entry form (available from the website www.hoy.co.nz)

Conditions of Entry:

1. This event is run under ESNZ Para-Equestrian Rules, ESNZ Generals Rules and Regulations and ESNZ Dressage Rules where applicable
2. Disclaimer of Liability (Article 160)
3. All riders must be current, full members of ESNZ at time of entry
4. Only entries received on official ESNZ entry forms, accompanied by all fully completed additional forms and correct entry fees will be accepted
5. All horses must be registered with ESNZ
6. Team tests are warm up classes and do not count towards the overall title for each grade
7. The Freestyle is weighted 1.5 towards the final title points

8. No prior qualification applies; however all Para-Equestrian riders must have a current FEI Classification Card or an ESNZ Para-Equestrian National Classification Card. A copy of this is to be included with entries and to be available at the competition
9. Riders are to wear the orange disk on their saddle blankets at all times whilst riding for ease of identification by stewards
10. The Para-Equestrian Dressage draw will be available via email and on the ESNZ (www.nzequestrian.org.nz) and HOY (www.hoy.co.nz) websites
11. Scratchings before March 12th must be notified to Joanna Smith (021 131 7565) or email: para@nzequestrian.org.nz
12. Scratchings during the show will not be refunded without a vet/doctor's certificate
13. All competitors and persons responsible must ensure they read the general conditions of the show

15. All Para-Equestrian horses are required to stay on the grounds for the duration of the show as per the ESNZ Para-Equestrian Rules and Regulations (Article 124, point 9)
16. The Para-Equestrian Organising Committee reserves the right to amend, move, cancel any class or ALTER or withdraw prize money
17. Arena Familiarisation times will be advertised on the rider's notice board
18. Prize-giving will be unmounted at the conclusion of each day –details will be on the riders' notice board
