RULES

Entries Closed 16th January 2014. 25% per horse late fee for entries made on the day for SH and SJ events.

- 1. All competitors and public enter at their own risk.
- 2. All competitors in pony events to be under 17 years of age
- 3. In all events a minimum of four entries are required or no 2nd or 3rd prizes will be awarded. In all events a minimum of six entries are required or no 3rd prize will be awarded.
- 4. Any protest must be lodged with the Secretary no later than 15 minutes after completion of the event in question. Protests must be accompanied by a fee of \$10 which will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
- 5. NO EVENT WILL BE DELAYED PENDING THE ARRIVAL OF AN ENTRANT.
- 6. Riders in pony events may be asked to present height certificates.
- 7. All classes run under current E.S.N.Z Rules and Series Conditions.
- 8. Unregistered horses and ponies may enter Training classes and Local Championships.
- 9. Horses and Ponies may compete in a maximum of <u>three</u> (3) show jumping events.
- 10. The Committee reserves the right to substitute trophies or vouchers of equal value for any cash prize.
- 11. Prizes not collected on the day will be forfeited.
- 12. The decisions of the Committee in all events shall be final and not amenable to any action of law.
- 13. The Committee reserves the right to add to, delete from or alter the programme or postpone the Sports Day if necessary.
- 14. Learner Jumping Ponies and children may also compete in jumping classes up to 60cm.
- 15. LOCAL HORSE & PONY: means competitors residing in Rangitikei District and also including Rangiwahia and Rewa districts.
- 16. Current start stickers must be attached to SJNZ entry forms for registered SH and SJ classes or entries will not be accepted.
