GENERAL CONDITIONS

- SCNO riders must submit the helpers form at <https://goo.gl/forms/zUY7isqiBulvKglp1> with their entries to nominate what jobs they can do to assist with running the show. Please bring a plate of food suitable for morning teas etc.
- Working Bee: Friday from 1pm.
- Programmes \$5. Can be paid with entries.
- ESNZ Community (free) Members may only compete in Introductory classes.
- Competitors ride at their own risk.
- Committee reserves the right to alter, amend or delete any class/prize money as it deems fit.
- Please enter on official entry forms. All fees to accompany entries or your entry won't be accepted.
- Yards \$15 & Stallion boxes \$40 for the duration.
- Administration fee of \$15 per equine and ESNZ J/SH levy of \$5 per equine. First aid fee \$5 per rider.
- Equines not registered for ESNZ J/SH can compete up to 110cm(ponies)/120cm(horses). They cannot compete in national series/high points classes, and must pay a \$15 Casual Jumping Levy, and an additional \$10 if competing both days. This levy does not apply to equines only competing in Introductory classes.
- Late entries plus 50% and ride in the order allocated.
- Scratchings to be advised at least the night before start of days competition. 75% refunds given with proof of inability to compete. Ph 027 321 4216.
- Refunds/Prize Money must be collected at show, or applied for in writing/email within 21 days of show.
- Cheques payable to SCNO Area Show Jumping.
- There will be no refunds given on late entries.
- Equines may only compete in one Championship or Grand/Mini Prix class.
- Pony riders must carry a current RAS height certificate.
- Minimum Standard of dress required for introductory classes. Formal Standard of dress required for all others.
- Run under ESNZ/JNZ/SHNZ rules and regulations.

SHOW HUNTER CONDITIONS

- Practise rounds start an hour prior to the ring start time both days. \$5 per round is to be paid at the gate.
- Equine Veterinary Services sponsor a rug and flower garland for the Horse gaining the most ESNZ Horse High Points over the 3 SCNO shows.
- Couplands Stockfeed sponsor a rug and flower garland for the Pony gaining the most high points over the 3 SCNO shows.
- Classes may run back to back at judge's discretion.
- Equines competing using the ESNZ Casual Jumping Levy will not be awarded HOYQ Points.
- For the high points classes ponies may only enter the category appropriate to their height.
- Prize Money only paid out to qualifying scores over 65.





World Jumping Challenge

Horse Inspection 10am Saturday.

Horse & Rider Participation - Category A

- WJC is a competition for horse/rider combinations (*this is **not** a competition for ponies*)
- A rider may ride two horses in Category A when competing in South Island events.
 - Nominated horses must be declared and ridden first in both rounds.
 - A declaration form must be submitted and signed by the President of the Ground Jury prior to the event starting.
 - Only nominated horses will count for points and World ranking.
- Riders that have participated in CS12* and over (including Senior Regional/Continental Games & Championships/WEG/OG/) in the last 3 years are **not** eligible to compete in any WJC
- Riders that have participated in FEI World Cup competitions in the current or preceding 2 seasons are **not** eligible to compete in any WJC. (*NZL restriction - Article 3 3.6 World Jumping Challenge rules*)
- Any rider that has not competed at the above mentioned level for more than 3 years are eligible to compete in the WJC
- Riders that have competed at the Youth Olympic Games **are** eligible to compete in the WJC
- Open to riders from the beginning of the year in which they reach their 15th birthday
- Riders and horses participating in the WJC are **NOT** required to be registered with the FEI

Horse Identification and Inspection

- All horses participating in a WJC must pass a horse inspection conducted by the FEI Veterinary Delegate and the FEI Judge
- The inspection must take place on a firm level and clean surface.
- In principle the horse inspection should take place the day before competition to allow for any eventual re- inspection
- It is compulsory for all horses to wear a three digit horse ID number as per *FEI Jumping rules Article 282* for the horse inspection and when competing. (*A three digit ID number must be allocated by the Organising committee of the event*)
- Horses must be 6 years or older
- FEI horse registration and passports are **NOT** required.
- All horses must be registered with (ESNZ) have an ESNZ Jumping annual start and be identifiable by a diagram.
- **ESNZ horse registration ID paper is required for all horses and must be available for the Veterinary Delegate at the horse inspection.**
