This show will be run under RAS Rules and has adopted the RAS Yellow Card system.

#### LIABILITY

The Organising Committee accepts no liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to ponies, horses, owners, riders, handlers, grooms or spectators, or to any other personal property whatsoever.

Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Venues.

Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate Animal Legislation and the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992.

#### GENERAL

• NO DOGS OR PETS are permitted on the Mystery Creek Grounds.

· Once judging starts for the day, rings can only be used whilst judging.

• The committee reserves the right to amalgamate or split classes depending upon number of entries received.

• If a horse or pony misbehaves to the extent that it unduly disturbs other competitors it will be asked to leave the ring.

• The Senior Steward in charge may, at their discretion, transfer an entry to its appropriate class where it is found to be wrongly entered. Advice to be given to the Secretary's office.

- All exhibits in ridden classes must be 3 years old and over.
- A Horse entered in the Novice section may enter in the open section.
- ALL competitors must park their floats and trucks in the area designated for this purpose NO EXCEPTIONS.

•Competitors may ride more than one horse or pony in title classes with the exception of Lead Rein and First Ridden titles. Another rider must be available to allow the judges to work the class together, if necessary. Any horse/pony not parading on the circle as required will be eliminated.

• Number holders are compulsory. Competitors to supply their own numbers

• No classes will be held up for a competitor or exhibit competing in another ring.

• Protest : All objections or protests must be lodged within an hour of the class accompanied with a \$50 fee to the head steward. Official protest forms are available at the show office.

#### FORBIDDEN SUBSTANCES

• The attention of the exhibitors is particularly drawn to the conditions relating to the misuse of drugs and the intention of the committee to undertake testing for forbidden substances. Your signature on the entry form and/or participation in the competition denotes your acceptance of these conditions.

**SUBSTITUTIONS** - Substitutions of any entry can only be made at the discretion of the show committee.

- NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON SHOW DAY.
- All entries and other fees to be paid in full at time of entry or entry will not be accepted.
- Purchase of Show Catalogue is compulsory. The cost of Catalogues must be paid for with entries.
- Catalogues will be available from 7.30am on show morning. These will be in your competitor goodie bags.
- A copy of a current height/performance certificate for horse or pony must be carried and presented to the head steward at the ring prior to the class starting & entering the ring or entry will be refused, with no refund.
- Novices must carry a copy of their performance card with them on show day. The definition of novice classes for horses or ponies that has yet to win 6 classes in any division within the competitions provided at any A&P show/event. They may have competed in an open section.
- Refunding entry fee. 50% of the entry fee will be refunded on the presentation of a Doctors or Veterinarians Certificate prior to 8.30am on show day and will be paid out one month after the show.
- The committee reserve the right to refuse or cancel any entry or refund without adjudicating any reason for doing so.
- Prize Money may be substituted for prizes at the discretion of the show committee. If less than 3 entries in a class, prize money may only be paid to 1st placing at the discretion of the show committee
- Prize Money will be paid out via Internet Banking within 21 days of the show
- RAS Levy of \$1.00 per class payable (Non RAS classes exempt Classes 68,69,71 & 73)
- ALL Novice competitors must enter and compete in either the Pony or Horse Novice Challenge. Failure to participate in this class will result in a forfeit of all prize money and awards/qualifications
- ALL Open competitors must enter and compete in the championship classes on Sunday. Failure to participate in this class will result in a forfeit of all prize money and awards/qualifications

ACCESS To Competition Area. Please note that the North Island Premier Showing Championships are being held within the premises of Mystery Creek however the area of competition is **OUTSIDE** the Equidays area therefore NIPSC Competitors are not require to purchase a gate entry to Equidays UNLESS you wish to attend Equidays.

NIPSC Competitors will receive a truck or float pass for your vehicle and gate Wristbands in order to gain access into the premises. These are free of charge and DO NOT get you into Equidays. Special arrangements have been made for all exhibits, grooms, supporters in the Supreme Ridden to be held within Equiday in the Indoor Area on the Sunday afternoon. These details will be in the Envelope for the Qualifier to the class.

Gates open every day of show at 6.30am and entrance is via Main Gate (GATE 2), no access prior to this time.

#### EQUIDAYS HEALTH and SAFETY CONDITIONS

Equidays has a zero harm policy and the safety of all people working at or visiting our venue is of the utmost importance to us. We appreciate your efforts in ensuring your site is safe at all times and that you take all practicable steps to ensure your own safety and take no action or inaction that causes harm to any other person.

Anyone participating in clinics or competitions associated with ESNZ disciplines, those attending the Pony Club Camp and any treks or pony rides must wear a helmet, however we strongly advise that ALL riders wear a helmet when training, competing and exhibiting to minimize the risk of injury in the event of an accident.

#### **VENUE RULES**

Competitors understand the risks associated with riding horses and acknowledge that your participation is informed and voluntary.

Every person entering the event zone" during setup or pack down must wear a high vis vest.

No dogs or pets are permitted on the Equidays site.

No digging, drilling or pegs are permitted without approval of the Equidays operations team due to live power, water and data cabling underground.

Any machinery or equipment must be certified, compliant and in safe working condition.

The site speed limit is 15km/h.

All vehicles onsite must drive on the roads only. Damage to sites by vehicle access, parking, manoeuvring or deliveries may result in penalties or remediation by the exhibiting company responsible for the damage.

All vehicles must have a fire extinguisher

All incidents, accidents or near misses must be reported to Equidays staff. Any fuels, gas or hazardous substances must be stored.

The highest standards of nutrition, health, sanitation and safety shall be encouraged and maintained at all times.

Adequate provision must be made for ventilation, feeding, watering and maintaining a healthy environment during transportation.


Emphasis should be placed on increasing education in training and equestrian practices and on promoting scientific studies in equine health. In the interests of the horse, the fitness and competence of the rider shall be regarded as essential.

All riding and training methods must take account of the horse as a living entity and must not include any technique considered by the FEI to be abusive.

National Federations should establish adequate controls in order that all persons and bodies under their jurisdiction respect the welfare of the horse.

The national and international Rules and Regulations in equestrian sport regarding the health and welfare of the horse must be adhered to not only during national and international events, but also in training.

Competition Rules and Regulations shall be continually reviewed to ensure such welfare
