

## **Conditions of Entry**

## Membership

• Riders require Full ESNZ Annual Membership

#### **Registration Requirements (Horses & Ponies)**

- \$5 ESNZ Jumping Levy is compulsory and is payable by all horses/ponies competing in Jumping and/or Show Hunter
- High Points and Equitation Series classes Full ESNZ Registration PLUS full Jumping Annual Start
- HOYQ (Horse of the Year Qualifier Classes) Full ESNZ Registration PLUS full Jumping Annual Start in order to be allocated HOYQ points
- Unregistered horses/ponies (or horses/ponies registered with ESNZ with no annual discipline start for SJ/SH can start using a **Casual Jumping Levy** of \$15 for the first day of the show and \$10 for each subsequent day of the same show. HOYQ points will **not** be allocated. (Note: \$5 ESNZ Jumping Levy is also payable and the rider must be a full member with ESNZ).

#### **Entry Restrictions & Conditions**

- Junior, Amateur, Adult classes for complete age and eligibility definition see SH rules on ESNZ website
- Ponies may only enter one height category (excludes Equitation)
- Pony High Points ponies may only enter the correct height related category:

Cat A 133cm & under

Cat B over 133cm & up to 143cm

Cat C over 143cm and up to & including 148cm

- Riders are allowed to ride one mount only in Rider Equitation classes and may only ride in one Equitation class
- NRM Pony Rider Equitation Class is open to any aged pony rider. Note: riders may not also enter the 'Empire Excavations Equitation 12yrs and under' Class (Riders Age as at 1 August 2016)
- Horses or ponies competing using the Casual Equine Start are not eligible for HOYQ Points (but are eligible for prize money) and cannot compete in **any** National Series classes
- Points Restricted classes open to those horses/ponies with 30 points or less as recorded by ESNZ as at 1 August 2016
- Rising Star Series open to those horses not jumping over 90cm
- Burger King Handy Hunter Horse Classic (1.05m) and Pony CAT B & CAT C (a) call-back follows first round TBC on day, (b) call-back at discretion of Committee based on time available
- Classes 37 ESNZ Combined Junior Rider & ESNZ Adult Rider Equitation National Series separate series points will be awarded but there will only be one set of prize money for the class
- 1.0m Championship (Classes 34 & 35) Overall Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded to the top scoring horses based on the combined scores from classes 34 & 35. Riders may compete in one or both classes but only those combinations that compete in both classes will be eligible for the overall Champion and Reserve Champion sashes.
- All classes are run under ESNZ rules. Show Hunter rules can be downloaded from www.nzequestrian.org.nz
- The organising committee reserves the right to alter, combine or cancel classes, alter prize money, substitute prizes in kind for prize money as they see fit and to limit classes if necessary
- All competitors enter at their own risk and must be familiar with the Health and Safety Policy of both Show Hunter Waitemata and Woodhill Sands Equestrian Centre
- ALL STALLION RIDERS MUST WEAR STALLION ARMBANDS WHEN MOUNTED

Scratchings received up until two days prior to show will be refunded less 25% (Entry Class Fee only). Scratchings during the show must be accompanied by a medical or veterinary certificate for refund. Ground/Administration and Yard Fees are non-refundable
- Warm-ups name must be on whiteboard half an hour prior to the start time of the first class. Please note: there will be **only one warm-up period** at the start of the day no warm-ups between categories or classes.

  - Casual Jumping Levy (if applicable) of \$15 for the first day of the show and \$10 for each subsequent day of the same show per horse or pony
  - Class Entry Fees as per Programme (Page 1 & 2)
- Warm Up Fee \$2.00 pay at the gate
- Late entries for all classes will incur a 25% penalty and changes may incur a \$2.00 fee
