

## Show Rules

### Purpose

This section identifies the "non-negotiable" rules of Upper Clutha A & P Society, that help ensure a safe Showgrounds and Show.

## Show Rules for Upper Clutha A&P Society

### General:

- Trade Exhibitors are responsible for Health and Safety at their site by identifying, eliminating or minimising any potential hazards to staff, volunteers, contractors and the general public.
- Before you **DIG** or **LIFT** refer to the Hazard Map to see where the underground and overhead services are.
- Obey signage and instructions from show officials.
- Show speed limit is **10 km** — no exceptions.
- There is to be No Smoking inside any marquees or showgrounds buildings.
- Always use residual current devices (RCD's) and tools and electrical leads are tagged /certified and well maintained.
- All tent and marquee pegs must be covered with sandbags or shrubs as must other dangerous spikes or protruding objects.
- All compressed gas cylinders must be secured to avoid tipping and must have snap couplings.
- No Trade Exhibitor shall install or maintain any LPG container greater than 10 kg.
- Watch out for each other — speak up if you think something is dangerous.

### Vehicles and Machinery:

- Public Safety is paramount — authorised vehicles only may be driven inside the showgrounds to a maximum speed of 10km. This is a public place and care and caution must be observed at all times.
- No vehicle movement after 8.30am -5pm (except authorised vehicles).
- No vehicles or trailers are permitted to remain inside the show area during show hours unless on the exhibitors site or as part of the overall display.
- All vehicles must be out of grounds by 8.30am.
- Exercise extreme care when backing. Use a spotter to ensure a safe work area especially when setting up and dismantling.
- Only delegated and trained operators are to use the show machinery.
- Children under the age of 16 years must not operate any machinery and must be at safe distances while machinery is in use.
- No children under 16 years old to drive quad bikes.
- Please be patient and courteous when assembling and disassembling your site at the end of the show.

### Animals

- No dogs are allowed on the show grounds unless competing at the A & P Show.
- No horses or livestock outside of their restricted zones.

### Emergencies

- Familiarise yourself with your nearest evacuation/emergency exit and follow instructions given over the PA system in the unlikely event of an emergency.
