ESNZ JUMPING AND CASUAL LEVIES

\$5 ESNZ Jumping Levy (Compulsory) payable by all horses/ponies competing in Jumping and or Showhunter. **\$20 Casual Jumping Levy**

The rider must be a full member with ESNZ. Horse/Pony not registered for ESNZ J/SH can compete using this levy.

The levy is \$20 for the show.

Can jump up to 1.00 on a pony and up to 1.10 on a horse. Cannot compete in series classes and will not be eligible for HOY points in SH.

Introductory Classes

Riders may compete in Introductory class (80cm and under for ponies and 90cm and under for Horses) on an Introductory Membership or Casual Membership Day Start. All other riders must be full members with ESNZ results will not be recorded with ESNZ for Introductory Classes.

Shows may choose to run registered classes at introductory heights where the rider must be a full ESNZ member and the horse may compete with a current Jumping/Show Hunter discipline start or on a Casual Jumping Levy results for these classes will be recorded on ESNZ records where applicable

Conditions

Show Hunter Conditions

- 1. Any class with less than 5 entries may be combined.
- 2. Show Hunter classes run under ESNZ Show Hunter Rules & Equitation Series Conditions 2015
- 3. All riders competing in Show Hunter HOYQ and Series Classes must have a current ESNZ Rider full Membership
- 4. Riders competing in Introductory Classes can be registered or compete on a Casual Membership
- 5. Equines with a current ESNZ annual registration and an Annual Jumping/Show Hunter Start will gain HOYQ and Series points.
- 6. Equines competing using the ESNZ Casual Equine Start will not gain any HOY Points and cannot compete in **ANY** Show Hunter Series Classes.
- 7. Ponies may jump in any classes but must jump in their correct category for their high points.

General Conditions

- 1. All entries must be made on official ESNZ entry forms or via main events Entries close on Fri 7th Dec with Lisa Parish, ph 0274070431 or email southlandshowjumping@hotmail.com
- 2. Enquiries welcome but NO phone entries accepted. Cheques payable to Southland Showjumping Group or bank direct to SBS 03-1355-0619034-000 be sure to use your name as reference.
- 3. All entry fees and prize money are inclusive of GST.
- 4. Combinations may only enter one Championship Class per day including Mini Prix and Grand Prix.
- 5. All competitors (inc unregistered), send full entry fees, **Including a \$5 NZ Showjumping Levy per horse/pony**. Plus a ground/administration fee of \$15 per horse/pony. **Both these fees are non-refundable, non-deductible, regardless of scratching**.
- 6. Stabling available for \$30, yards \$15 for the duration of the show.
- 7. There are no restrictions on how many classes you may enter, but please consider the welfare of your horse or pony. Organisers have the right to restrict the numbers of classes you are entered in if the number entries are excessive.
- 8. All riders, horses and ponies competing in OPEN CLASSES must be registered with ESNZ or use the casual levy system proof will be required.
- 9. The committee reserves the right to alter or amend the programme as it sees fit.
- 10. All competitions will be run under ESNZ rules.
- 11. Junior rider under 18 as at 1st August 2018.
- 12. Formal dress code for ring one. Art 256 1.5
- 13. All Southland riders must complete the attached form and supply a helper. Failure to do so will incur a \$40 fee payable before you are able to start in your first class.

14. Dogs must be on a leash at all times!

- 15. No electric fencing allowed.
- 16. A fee of \$2 will be charged for all class changes, these **MUST** be done an 30 minutes before the class starts.
- 17. Any entries received after the closing date will incur a 25% penalty fee.
- 18. Saturday night meal will cost \$10 per Adult and \$5 per children under 12. This is payable at the door NOT to the secretary.
- 19. Safety approved helmets must been worn while mounted at all times.
- 20. ESNZ BLUE CARD ruling for concussion will apply.
- 21. Health and Safety protocols with be available for viewing in the office and must be complied with as a condition of show entry.
- 22. ESNZ GRs Article 151: Regarding tagging protective headwear will apply
- 23. Class 29 and 29.1 are run in conjunction. If you wish to be eligible for both classes, you must enter both.

Criteria for Eligibility and Conditions for series

- 1. Points awarded to combinations over the five Otago Southland shows
- 2. Awards will be presented at the final Southland Show.
- 3. Series is open to all combinations. Not restricted to Otago and Southland riders
- 4. Pony points will be awarded from Open HOYQ and HiPoints classes
- 5. There will be a prize each for winner of Cat A, B, C Pony
- 6. Horse series points will be awarded from all HOYQ classes
- 7. There will be an Intro series points prize for horse and pony
- 8. The Intro series points will be awarded from the Intro classes
- 9. Points are allocated as follows 1st-7, 2nd-5, 3rd-4, 4th-3, 5th-2, 6th-1



2018 FEI WORLD JUMPING CHALLENGE

Horse Inspection 7:30am Saturday.

Horse & Rider Participation - Category A

- WJC is a competition for horse/rider combinations (this is not a competition for ponies).
- A rider may ride two horses in Category A when competing in South Island events.
 - o Nominated horses must be declared and ridden first in both rounds.
 - A declaration form must be submitted and signed by the President of the Ground Jury prior to the event starting. For the 3rd competition, declaration forms are to be signed by the FEI Foreign Judge.
 - Only nominated horses will count for points and World ranking.
- Riders that have participated in FEI CSI events (including Senior Regional/Continental Games & Championships/WEG/OG) or in FEI CSI competitions at 1.35m or higher are not eligible to compete in any WJC.
- Any rider that has not competed at the above-mentioned level for more than 3 years are eligible to compete in the WJC.
- Riders that have competed at the Youth Olympic Games are eligible to compete in the WJC.
- Open to riders from the beginning of the year in which they reach their 14th birthday.
- Riders and horses participating in the WJC are NOT required to be registered with the FEI.

Horse Identification and Inspection

- All horses participating in a WJC must pass a horse inspection conducted by the FEI Veterinary Delegate and the FEI Judge.
- The inspection must take place on a firm level and clean surface.
- Horse Inspection 7:30am Saturday.
- It is compulsory for all horses to wear a three-digit horse ID number as per *FEI Jumping rules Article 282* for the horse inspection and when competing. (*A three-digit ID number will be allocated by the Organising committee of the event*).
- Horses must be 6 years or older.
- FEI horse registration and passports are NOT required.
- All horses must be registered with ESNZ have an ESNZ Jumping annual start and be identifiable by a diagram.
- ESNZ horse registration ID paper is required for all horses and must be available for the Veterinary Delegate at the horse inspection.
