

2019 NZ NATIONAL JUMPING CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW CONDITIONS

Unregistered horses may ONLY enter Ring 3 classes and MUST pay the Casual levy of \$20. ALL HORSES/PONIES ENTERING SHOWJUMPING CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES MUST BE CURRENTLY REGISTERED WITH ESNZ TO JUMP AT NATIONALS ALL SHOWHUNTER HORSES/PONIES MUST BE CURRENTLY REGISTERED.

All classes run under ESNZ rules and regulations and Annex 8. **Disclaimer of Liability ESNZ General regulations 160.** The committee has the right to refuse entries.
Reservation of Right ESNZ General Regulation 114 point 4.

2. All entry fees and charges to be paid at time of entry:

- 50% penalty fee for late entries
- \$2 fee for class change/transfer.

3. Scratchings are to be notified to the Secretary the day before or by 7.30am prior to the commencement of the day's competition. Refunds less 25% on proof of the horse's inability to compete. No refunds will be considered if not notified prior or during the show.

4. There may be testing for prohibited substances during the show.

5. The organisers reserve the right to alter or delete the programme as they see fit.

6. Qualification – refer Annex 8 Article 32.

7. The Horse Grand Prix will be awarded Premier level points.

8. Fees: ESNZ Jumping Levy:	\$5 payable by all horses/ponies competing
Administration fee:	\$7 per Rider
Ground fee:	\$15 per horse/pony for one day \$20 per horse/pony for two days \$25 per horse/pony for three days.
Stables & covered yards:	\$20 per day/night (per box)
Yards:	\$5 per day/night per yard
Camping:	\$20 per unit
Powered site:	\$20 per day/night
Catalogue:	\$5 if prepaid with entries or \$7 at show

9. The organising committee will comply with IRD rules regarding payment of withholding tax on prize money over \$500 per class. Competitors must have available for the secretary their IRD numbers for this purpose. Prize money will not be released for classes (where the individual receives greater than \$500 for that class if an IR330 is not completed prior to receipt of this money. IR330 available from secretary.

10. GST: All entry fees and prize money is GST inclusive.

11. North Island horses travelling south are eligible for a ESNZ for a subsidy.

The National Championship Classes normally run under Article 38 are being run under a trial shortened format with the rules differing slightly to those in the rule book. Please refer to the draft of the trial rules as an appendix to this schedule.

Note: . The restriction of participation if there are more than 20 in the final round is at the discretion of the organising committee (not automatic), we will make a decision by 5pm Saturday evening and notify on noticeboard at office if participation is to be restricted Those competitors not making the top 20 for the final day and those who have been eliminated, may transfer to non-championship classes of the same height or one lower with the secretary the night before. Entry fees apply for these classes but no late fee applies

SHOWHUNTER CONDITIONS:

All classes will be run under SH Rules 2018 & SHNZ Equitation Series Conditions 2018.

Classes denoted (Q) are qualifying rounds for title and championship classes on the final day.

There will be up to 15 qualifiers for title classes for the Rising, Amateur and Junior and up to 20 for the Open.

The first five place getters in each qualifying class will qualify for the Title class in that division as long as they score 66% or above.

The remaining places in the title classes (if required) will be made up of the next highest scores from the qualifying classes providing they score 66% or above.

The title class does not carry points forward – it is a totally new class.

All ponies must jump in their own category.

Pony Rising Star Classic – riders will jump in their own heights but will be run as one class.

Pony Handy Hunter Classic Championship – riders will jump in their own heights but will be run as one class.

Flexi Starts not permitted at this show.

South Island Teams Event – detail to be advertised later – no further classes – teams compete in "normal" classes and have points collated. Teams consist of three children (Category A<B and C) and three adults.

HORSES TITLE & CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES QUALIFIERS - if you enter these classes and Qualify for the final there is no further entry fee to pay for the title/championship class.

- Rising Star Championship – Classes 201 & 238
- Junior Title – classes 203 and 240
- Amateur Title – classes 204 and 241
- Open Title – classes 207 and 243
