### RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRIES CLOSE: **Monday 9 December**

**ENTER ONLINE at [WWW.Main-Events.com](http://WWW.Main-Events.com)**

General Rules and Regulations for the governance and conduct of the Te Kauwhata A & P Show shall be the same as previously. If any exhibitor is not sure of the conditions they should get in touch with the Secretary.

Yellow Card - This Show/Event supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system. A Yellow Card will be issued, in cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. Full wording of the 'Yellow Card' system is available to view on the RAS website – [www.ras.org.nz](http://www.ras.org.nz).

Clean Sport - The Rules of the Royal A&P Society New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the person responsible's risk. Forbidden Substance - Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.

Arrears - No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other Show/Event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.

Summary of RAS Resolution Process – the full process can be found on the RAS website [www.ras.org.nz](http://www.ras.org.nz). The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the show. If the matter is in regards to an RAS official, the show may request the assistance of RAS Head Office as to how to deal with this in an appropriate manner.

The Association will not be responsible for any accident in competitions or that may occur from machinery or other exhibits or plants belonging to exhibitors, competitors or the Association and it is a condition of entry that such exhibitor, competitor or visitor shall hold the Association blameless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings issuing from any accidents so caused.

Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the showgrounds.

Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate Animal Legislation and the Health & Safety at Work Act 2015 and any amendments.

No person is permitted in any judging ring without express permission from the Head Steward of that ring. Only persons directly responsible for an exhibit are permitted in the marshalling area.

No classes will be held up for competitors competing in other rings, there are no exceptions.

**ENTRY FEES & PRIZE MONEY:**

Members of the Te Kauwhata A&P Association are entitled to a \$2 discount on each class entered. You can pay for or renew a membership with your entry fees. Membership is \$12.00/annum.

Te Kauwhata A&P reserve the right to exchange prize money for products when available.

Te Kauwhata A & P Association reserve the right to reduce prize money. Prize money will be reduced to 1st and 2nd place if only 4 in class.

**GROUNDS FEES:** \$10 per equestrian competitor (max \$30), \$5 per livestock (goat) competitor (max \$20).

**LATE ENTRIES:**

Late entries will be accepted up until 8.15 am on show day at a fee of standard entry fee plus 50%. Entries on the day will be accepted in the Have A Go Grassroots Ribbon day rings.

## PROUD TO BE PARTICIPATING IN THE MID-NORTHERN DISTRICT (RAS) ACCUMULATOR

All riders, including harness drivers, with the exclusion of heavy horse (Clydesdale) working classes, competing at RAS affiliated A&P Shows/Events must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area collecting rings or anywhere else within a Showgrounds. Hats/helmets must conform with one of the current approved safety standards and be tagged with the current recognised tag implemented by NZPCA, ESNZ and RAS. These standards may be subject to change but the latest list can be found at <http://www.ras.org.nz> – equestrian. RAS will advise any changes via their website and Facebook

The RAS equestrian levy is included in the Entry fee per class.

RAS Height Certificates are to be carried at all times. Entry to classes will be declined if height certificate not produced for classes requiring same.

### REFUND OF ENTRIES

If a pony or horses is entered for the show but the animal or rider through injury or illness is prevented from competing at the Show, and a Veterinary, Farrier or Doctor's certificate confirming the fact is received at the Secretary's office by 10am on Show Day, 50% of the entry fees paid are refundable. If the horse or pony competes at the Show or the respective certificates are not received with the specified time the right to receive a refund is forfeited.

### ENTRY FEES & PRIZE MONEY

Te Kauwhata A&P reserve the right to exchange prize money for product when available.

Members of the Te Kauwhata A&P Association are entitled to a \$2 discount on each class entered. You can pay or renew your membership with your entry fees. Membership is \$12.00/annum.

Te Kauwhata A&P Association reserve to right to reduce prize money. Prize money may be reduced to 1st and 2nd place if only 4 in class.

### GROUND FEES

\$10 per horse to a maximum of \$30

### LATE ENTRIES

Late entries will be accepted up until 8.15am on show day at a fee of standard entry fee plus 50%. Entries on the day will be accepted in the GRASSROOTS Ribbon day rings at no penalty.

## First Ridden - HOY Qualifier

To provide a transition from the Lead Rein section to the open ridden section, where a rider does not have to canter on the circle in company. For that reason First Ridden Ponies should be safe and suitable. They should possess a good front, even gaits and not be too wide for their small riders. The stride should not be too long, as this would unseat the rider and cause the rider to lose balance. Ideally the First Ridden Pony is a little more scopey in both conformation and movement than the Lead Rein Pony, although many ponies compete successfully in both sections. A First Ridden Rider is only able to compete in this section for a maximum of twenty-four (24) months. First Ridden Ponies not to exceed 138cm. First Ridden Ponies must be ridden in a snaffle bridle with a cavesson noseband, a snaffle bit and a single rein. A First Ridden Pony may compete in the Open ring with a different rider. No spurs to be worn. A cane or a whip not exceeding 68cm in length, which includes a flap 2cm wide by 4cm long, may be carried by riders in the First Ridden Section. Judging Criteria: Judged on - 60% suitability, temperament and safeness - 40% conformation and paces. All ponies to walk and trot in company, but may be asked to canter in their individual workout. The same Rider and Pony cannot enter in both the Lead Rein Section and the First Ridden Section or in an open ring, but a pony that has been entered in the Lead Rein, Group B or Group C Sections can be entered in the First Ridden Section with a different rider (who is eligible to compete in this section). A rider who has moved from the First Ridden into the open rings forfeits the right to compete again in any First Ridden Events at any A&P Show, affiliated show or event, or any show that the RAS may from time to time designate as a show requiring specific qualifications (e.g. Horse of the Year)

# Miniature Horses
