Jumping Conditions

- 1. All classes run under ESNZ rules.
- 2. Riders, horses and ponies must have a current ESNZ registration for the duration of the show where required.
- 3. Formal standard of dress required.
- 4. Classes 1, 4, 5, 6, & 15 can compete using the Casual Equine Registration of \$20 per show. All riders must be full members of ESNZ.
- 5. Classes 9, 10, 12, 13, 17, 18 & 19 are run under Series Conditions and are eligible for National Series Points.
- 6. Classes 7 & 8 will run indoors on Friday night starting at 6.30pm.
- Classes 21 & 22 is open to all ESNZ registered combinations in Eventing and/or Jumping disciplines. Please refer to Eventing Challenge Conditions on page 4. Riders can wear Show Jumping or Cross Country attire but will be required to wear an ESNZ approved body protector/vest for this class.
- 8. Times are approximate, any major change will be communicated to you via text
- 9. Maximum of 3 horses per rider per class
- 10. Equifest reserves the right to cap class numbers as appropriate.
- 11. Each rider receives 1 x wristband. Extra wristbands can be purchased via Main Events when you enter \$40 (\$35 saving) these are limited to 3x extra wristbands.
- 12. A \$5 ESNZ Jumping Levy is applicable to each horse.
- 13. A \$20 non-refundable admin and medic fee applies per rider.
- 14. A \$40 ground fee per horse applies.
- 15. Equifest reserves the right to exchange cash for products to a maximum of 50%.
- 16. Entries close Monday 23 November 2020. Please enter online at mainevents.co.nz
- Scratchings refund for all classes and other fees less 25%. Subject to proof of inability to compete. Subject to conditions and refund form being completed within 7 days of the event. Stable and yard fees will be fully refunded up until 23 November 2020.
- 18. All prize money will be paid via internet banking.
- 19. Open yards \$40 and covered yards \$100 for the duration of the event.
- 20. Stables \$180 for the duration of the event. All stallions must be stabled when not being ridden. (stables & covered yards are limited)
- 21. Camping: Non-powered sites are \$40. These prices are per site, not per person.
- 22. Equifest reserves the right to alter, delete or amend any class as it sees fit.
- 23. Equifest takes no responsibility for injury or loss to competitor, horse or gear.
- 24. DOGS dogs are allowed but must remain in the camping area and on a lead at all times. No dogs around the yards or in the event zone.
- 25. All yarded & stabled equines are to have their name, the name of the person responsible and the telephone number clearly visible on their head collar and/or rugs as per Jumping

Equifest Eventing Challenge

Open to all ESNZ Registered riders and horses of jumping and eventing disciplines.

Judged under ESNZ Rules.

The first phase will be run over 6-8 portable and fixed cross country fences - **not against the clock.** Riders will proceed directly into the next phase. The second phase will be run over 6-8 show jumps - **against the clock**. A Joker may be included in the show jumping phase.

If there happens to be equal placings, then the final placings will be determined by the combination who has gone the closest to the optimum time in the first phase (cross country).

Penalties will be as follows:

- Knockdown of a show jump 4 penalties
- 1st refusal of any jump
- 2nd refusal of any jump
- 3rd refusal of any jump
- Horse and/or rider fall
- Retaking obstacle already jumped
- Starting before the bell
- Error of course
- Exceeding the Time Limit
- Time penalties

- ESNZ approved safety helmet and must be tagged
- ESNZ approved safety vest
