Types of Classes

TA1 Article 238.1.1

Al (1 Round not against the clock)

In a Table Al class, competitors with equal jump penalties share equal placings. Placings are not determined by the time taken to complete the round e.g. all clear rounds are first equal.

A2 Article 238.2.1

(1 Round against the clock)

In a Table A2 class, competitors with equal penalties for any place are positioned in accordance with the time taken to complete the round. The competitor with the least faults and the fastest time wins.

AM5 Article 238.2.2

(A Jump off class against the clock)

The first round is timed, however if there are competitors tied for first place after the first round with equal jump faults) a jump-off will be carried out. The jump-off is also timed. The winner will be the competitor with the least faults and the fastest time in the jump-off. Those who jumped off fill 5 the top placings based on faults and time in the jump-off. The rest of the placings are filled by the competitors who had the next least jump faults, and based on their time in the first round.

Article 238.1.2

AM3 (A jump-off class, first round not against the clock)

An AM3 competition is not based on the time taken to complete the round (not against the clock), but has a time limit (time allowed). If competitors have equal penalties for first place, they will jumpoff. The jump off will be against the clock. The winner will be the competitor with the least faults and the fastest time in the jump-off. Those who jumped off fill the top placings based on faults and time in the jump-off. If not, all placings are filled with those with equal jump faults in the first round and will be placed equally.

Two Phase Article 274

The competition runs over two phases without interruption (i.e. the finishing line for the first phase is the starting line for the second phase). Competitors penalised (jump or time faults) in the first phase are halted by ringing the bell after jumping the last obstacle in the first round, and must stop after crossing the first finishing line. The competitor who jumps clear in the first phase, and has the least faults and the fastest time in the second phase wins.

Take Your Own Line (TYOL)Article 271

- 1. In this competition the obstacles may be jumped only once in the order chosen by the competitor. Any competitor who does not jump all the obstacles is eliminated. Combination obstacles are not allowed.
- 2. Competitors may cross the starting line or finishing line in either direction. The lines must be provided with four flags; a red and a white flag at each end of these lines. Obstacles may be jumped in either direction, unless otherwise directed on the course plan.
- 3. This competition takes place without a laid down speed, under Table C.
- 4. If the rider has not completed the course 120 seconds after the round has started, they will be eliminated.
- 5. All disobediences are penalised by the time lost by the competitor.
- 6. If there is a refusal or run-out with a knock-down or displacement of the obstacle, the competitor may only restart their round when the obstacle knocked down or displaced has been replaced and when the Ground Jury gives the signal to start. They may then jump the obstacle of choice. In this case 6 seconds for time correction (Article 232, page 21) will be added to the time of the round.

Conditions

- Entries for this event will open on the 21st December and close when full or on Sunday 3rd of January.
- If we are in the position to accept late entries this will be with a 25% surcharge on classes. NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY.
- ONLINE ENTRIES ONLY (main-events.com) no postal or emailed entries accepted. Upon completion of your entry you should receive a confirmation email to your Main-Events.com login email address. Please check this carefully. If you don't receive this it may mean your entry hasn't been completed properly so please follow up. Please make sure your email address is up-to-date as all communication will go to this address.
- PAYMENTS can be made by using Poli Pay or Credit Card through Pay Pal.
- Class changes \$2, no refunds for prices of lesser value. Class changes must be done 30 minutes before the start of the class.
- REFUNDS less 20% for scratchings made BEFORE Thursday 8TH January. SCRATCHINGS MUST BE NOTIFIED through Main-events.com No Facebook messages or txt messages will be accepted. (No refunds for all other scratching's except on production of a medical or vet certificate.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to alter or cancel classes as they see fit and to limit classes if necessary.
- Prize money paid out as advertised. Extra prize money will be paid out at a ratio of 1:7 starters.
- ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS OR MOTORBIKES AT OUR EVENT
- Competitors and spectators attend the event at their own risk. By entering you are agreeing to Show Jumping Waitemata & Woodhill Sands Health & Safety policies.
- Rookie Riders riders 21 and under as of the 1st of August 2020. Open to combinations not competing above 1.20m at this event.
- Amateur Rider riders 22 and over (as of the 1st of August 2020) who
 have not placed in events above 1.25m in the current and preceding
 season. Open to combinations not competing above 1.20m at this event.

\$5 ESNZ Jumping Levy (Compulsory) – payable by all horses/ponies competing in Jumping and or Show Hunter.

\$20 Casual Jumping Levy

The rider must be a full member with ESNZ. Horse/Pony not registered for ESNZ J/SH can compete using this levy.

The levy is \$20 for the show.

Can jump up to 1.00m on a pony and up to 1.10m on a horse. Cannot compete in series classes and will not be eligible for HOY points in SH.

Introductory Membership <u>or</u> \$15 Casual Membership Day Start

Riders may compete in Introductory class (80cm and under for ponies and 90cm and under for Horses) on an Introductory Membership or Casual Membership Day Start. All other riders must be full members with ESNZ – results will not be recorded with ESNZ for Introductory Classes.
