- Canterbury Shows – Labour Weekend, Xmas Cracker & Canterbury Champs
- Point system to be consistent with those currently being used for National Series;
 - Premier Show – 20,17,14,11,8,4
 - Grand Prix Show – 10,8,6,4,2,1
- Except for Horse Grand Prix Series which is a three tier point system including PL, HGP & HMP
- To be eligible, horses are to have competed in the series class at two Canterbury Areas shows.

Kinloch Farms - Canterbury Horse Grand Prix Series

Conditions:

- Points for this series to be gained by the HORSE, must be the same combination for the season.
- Horses to have competed at a minimum of 2 Canterbury Area run shows.
- Shows will be Canterbury Area: Labour Weekend, Xmas Cracker and Canterbury Champs.
- Classes to count: Horse Mini Prix (HMP), Grand Prix (HGP) or Premier League (PL)
- Points from only ONE of the above classes/horse/show to count, nomination is required at time of entry, if entering more than one of the above classes.
- Horse Mini Prix (HMP) is to be run at a height no lower than 1.35m (or 1.30 – 1.40m)
- Riders gaining first round faults of 12 or more do not gain points.
- Points allocation; 1st 2nd 3rd 4th 5th 6th
PL - 30 25 20 15 10 7
GP - 20 17 14 11 8 4
MP - 10 8 6 4 2 1
- Points won by competitors or horses that are placed equal are added and divided equally.

Tavern Harewood – Gentleman Rider Series

- Rug, sash & trophy
- For male riders competing on horses
- Each Canterbury show the rider is to nominate one mount for point collection, it can be a different mount at each show
- Points to be awarded from any Open Jumping or Show Hunter class results at each show. 1st = 7 points, 2nd = 5, 3rd = 4, 4th = 3, 5th = 2, 6th = 1.
- All points will be collated at Canterbury Champs and rider with the most points wins.

Graham McClintock Future Rider Series

- Will be run over 2 qualifying classes at Labour Weekend Show and one last chance qualifying class on the Friday of Xmas Cracker
- Final to be 2 rounds and a possible jump off to be run at lunch time on the Sunday of Xmas Cracker
- Run as a 1.2m qualifier with the final 2 rounds at 1.20m, both rounds against the clock
- For combinations that have not had placings at 1.3m or above
- There will be a \$50 nomination fee up front in addition to the entry fee for the qualification classes. Championship must be entered and paid prior for any points to be allocated.
- 25 combinations will qualify for the final. 10 from the first qualifier on Sunday of Labour Weekend, 10 from the second qualifier on the Monday of Labour Weekend (that have not already qualified) 5 from the last chance qualifier on the Friday of Xmas Cracker (that have not already qualified)
- There will be a rug and garland for the winner of the final
- Prize Money will be allocated at \$1000, \$500, \$300, \$200, \$100 and Rosettes will be awarded to 10th place in the final

ConcretePower Junior Amateur Rider Series

- Competitors must ride horses that are registered with ESNZ in their name as owner or part owner or registered lease as per the ESNZ Amateur Rider series rules.
- Competitors will be eligible to take part in this series from the beginning of the season when they reach the age of 17 until the end of the season during which they reach the age of 21, the season being from 1 August until 31 July. All competitors must be full ESNZ members.
- Competitors may not have won prize money as a combination in any jumping class over 1.25m or competed in any other Series or Horse Age Group classes or 3* eventing competition, during the current or preceding season at any ESNZ show, with the exception of Junior Rider. The combination may have competed in Junior Rider last season but must not now be eligible to compete in Junior Rider this current season.
- If you are eligible and you ride as a combination in another series class throughout the current season that removes your eligibility, you simply do not enter this class again and points will be scratched.
- The competitor may ride more than one horse in the Junior Amateur Series but must nominate the point scoring horse and ride it first.
- The competition will be run in conjunction with the Amateur Rider class at each show.

ConcretePower Equitation Awards - Ring 3

- For riders competing in Ring 3 ONLY at each show. Riders are not eligible if they are riding a different mount in any other ring.
 - There will be one Equitation rosette awarded to a pony combination and one Equitation rosette awarded to a horse combination on each day of the show and presented at the end of the last pony or horse class as relevant.
 - They will be judged on overall turnout of horse and rider, ring craft, and potential to progress in the sport of show jumping.
 - There is no cost to enter.
