# COVID-19 Alert Level 2 Policy



Every person on the grounds participating in this event has specific obligations under this policy.

A reminder that failure to follow the conditions outlined in this policy may result in immediate disqualification from the show and removal from the grounds.

### General

- You must stay at home if you are unwell.
- No spectators or members of the public only competitors, support persons (1 per competitor), and officials/volunteers are permitted to enter the grounds. All support persons must be named prior to the show. We will keep a record of all attendees and their contact details, and will provide this to the Ministry of Health if requested.
- Everyone aged 12 and over must check-in QR codes are placed at all access gates and the office. If you cannot check-in using the app please do so at the show office.
- Everyone aged 12 and over must have a face covering Face coverings are mandatory inside all public buildings. Any time people are moving about and likely to come within 2m of someone else not in their bubble, it is recommended they should wear a face covering.
- **Keep your distance** Maintain a 2 metre distance from people outside your bubble at all times.
- Base yourself at your car/truck/float use it for storing your belongings, resting, and picnicking. Please make use of your own toilet/shower facilities if you have them.
- **Practice good hygiene** Wash your hands frequently, cough/sneeze into your elbow, and use the hand sanitiser and/or hand washing facilities provided.
- Additional restrictions may apply as government guidelines are updated.

## Competitors/support persons

- Are split into separate designated areas of up to 100 persons, with separate parking, yarding, and toilets for each area. Toilets will be colour coded. Showers only available to those who are camping and do not have their own facilities.
- You must not enter a designated area to which you have not been assigned at any time.
   Anyone found to be in breach of this condition will be disqualified from the show and asked to leave the grounds.
- No refunds will be provided if you do not abide by our rules and guidelines.

## Officials/volunteers

 You are all considered part of one workplace bubble. The rotating of officials will be avoided when possible. Car parking is in the shingled area behind the Office or the grass area to the west of the office or in the camping area for Officials beside the concrete ablution block that will be roped off

 You should wear a face covering at all times if you are required to enter a designated area to which you are not assigned, or when you interact face to face with competitors/support persons (presentations, course walks, etc.)

### **Indoor Areas**

- Only 2 competitors/support persons are permitted in the office at any one time. Electronic
  methods for class changes will be available and encouraged, forms will still be available.
- The toilets and showers located in the concrete ablutions block are solely for the use of officials/volunteers.
- Hand sanitiser and/or hand washing facilities will be available at all indoor areas.
- Officials/volunteers lunch will be served seated, not buffet style.

## First Aid and Emergencies

- Minimum distances do not apply, but close contact should be kept to less than 15 minutes.
- Appropriate PPE must be worn if the patient is exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms.
- A supply of surgical masks and gloves will be held by the organising committee.

## Designated Areas (please confer with the map)

#### Blue

- All blue allocated stabling
- Parking between New Covered Yards and new open yards and in front of new open yards
- Toilet: Portacom labelled Blue.

#### Yellow

- All yellow allocated stabling
- Parking between New Covered Yards and portacom ablution block and west end of WaterForce Ring 3 if overflowed
- Toilet: Portacom labelled Yellow.

#### White

- All white allocated stabling
- Parking east side of hedge between hedge and open yards and east side of open yards
- Toilet: Portacom labelled White.

#### **Pink**

- All pink allocated stabling
- Parking west side of concrete ablution block
- Toilet / showers: concrete ablution block

#### Red

- All red allocated stabling
- Parking middle of driveways
- Toilet: Portacom labelled Red

### **Purple**

- Parking left of drive way in
- Toilet: Portaloo labelled Purple

#### Green

- Parking to the right of drive way in
- Toilet: Portaloo labelled Green

#### **Black**

- Parking in Siberia, nose into the hedge out by the Pony Show Hunter ring. Please do not let horses dig holes and pick up every single piece of hay and manure. Directions on the map and please follow the cones out there and do not wander outside the cone points for your own safety.
- Toilet: Portaloo labelled Black
