HORSE ACCOMMODATION:

For those competing large teams or in ring one classes you can pre-book yards prior to placing your entries by emailing horses@waiaps.org.nz

All yards will be allocated on a first in first served basis when you place your entries/prebook.

\$60.00 - Covered yards with saw dust, Merve Renal or in the Pavilion

\$40.00 - Covered yards with straw, Arcus Block or in the Pavilion

\$25.00 - Wooden yards (horses only, no ponies)

\$20.00 - Open Pipe Yards

\$15.00 - Wooden Pony Yards

\$20.00 - Add Sawdust to my Wooden/Open Yard (per yard)

Any horses in the wrong yards will be impounded by the committee, these horses can be collected upon payment of a \$50.00 cash impound fee.

\$5.00 fee applies to any yard tags not returned, \$50.00 cleaning fee applies to any stables or yards not cleaned out.

COVID-19: This schedule is prepared on the basis that we are in Level 1 at the time of competition.

If the Wairarapa region is in level 2, 3 or 4 at the time of competition full refunds will be paid for any entries

Entries will not be accepted from any competitors from regions in level 3 or 4.

GATE PASSES/ACCESS:

Please include passes as required in your main events entries.

Riders receive complimentary passes limited to one per rider

Support/ground help can also receive complimentary passes limited to one per rider

Additional passes can be purchased (discounted) via main events when placing entries, or purchased over the weekend at the gate.

Trucks and floats entering through gate 1 will not be asked for these at the gate. Cars will be stopped and asked for passes to be scanned/wrist bands if your pass has already been scanned.

Please unload etc and arrange to have your gate passes scanned and swapped for wrist bands at the horse secretaries office.

This enables us to have an accurate list of who was on the grounds for any tracing requirements as well as giving you access to the show outside of the equestrian areas.

PARKING: Please see map (included in schedule and also on Main Events for parking)

CUPS/TROPHIES: All cups/trophies will be retained and engraved by Wairarapa A & P Society.

Trophies will be available for photos and can be collected from the main office and returned after you have taken your photos etc, you will need to know the name of the trophy when collecting.

LEVIES:

A levy pack is required for each horse/pony, discounted levies are available for those entering 3 or more horses (i.e if entering 5 horses 3 of these can be discounted. Your entries should show 5 standard levies and 3 levy discounts)

An administration fee of \$5.00 applies for any incorrect levies including ESNZ casual/introductory levies.

CATALOGUE: Printed catalogues can be added (\$10.00) to your entries on main events, these can be collected at the horse office.

An online version will also be available on main events

ENTRIES CLOSE ON 15TH OCTOBER 2021

Late entries will be accepted online until 25th October but will incur a 50% penalty and may not be catalogued.

No entries will be accepted after 25th October.

No email entries will be accepted.

Payment must accompany entries, any entries received but not paid by the closing date will be considered late.

Entries will be accepted via the Main Events website or on our own entry form which will be available on Main Events.

The correct names and registration numbers of all horses, ponies and riders must be stated on the entry form.

No entry will be considered valid unless the entry form has been completed as above.

Exhibitors must read the rules of ESNZ and RAS and check their entry form carefully.

Entry in this show confirms that you have read and accept the rules under which our event is run.

Entry in the Show entitles the Society to publish an Exhibitors name in results and distribute with Exhibitor Lists.

The Society reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without giving a reason for doing so

The Society reserves the right to cancel sections and classes if there are insufficient entries.

SWAP/SCRATCH/ADD (CLASS/HORSE):

Class swaps after 15th October will be charged at -75% of the original entry fee, plus the new entry fee.

Late entry fees will not apply to swapped classes when the swap out of/into classes are nominated at the same time.

Late entry fees will apply to any classes added after 15th October

Refunds after 15th October are per the refund policy below

Class swaps/late entries must be received by the secretary by 6pm the day prior to the class including those sent via email.

Class swaps must be on the appropriate form completed in the office or by email with complete information (horse name, rider name, class change required) any balance resulting will be followed up after the event.

This only applies to horses and riders already entered in the show, no new horses or riders can be entered after 25th October.

REFUNDS FOR SCRATCHING:

100% refund of entry including levies and yards if horse secretary is advised before 6pm on the 15th October 2021

75% refund of entry including levies and yards if horse secretary is advised before 6pm on the 25th October 2021 with a vet or doctors certificate for the horse or rider entered.

50% refund of entry including levies and yards if horse secretary is advised before 6pm on the 1st November 2021 with a vet or doctors certificate for the horse or rider entered.

NOVICE:

A Novice horse or pony or rider is one that has yet to win 6 show classes in any division within the competitions provided at an A & P Show. Upon achieving the sixth win in a division, a pony, horse or rider thereafter must compete in the appropriate open classes within that division. i.e. not to have won three firsts - (0-2 wins) not to have won six firsts - (0-5 wins)

Once a horse/pony/rider has three wins they are no longer eligible and can only go in the 0-5 wins class, once they have six wins they can no longer enter in a novice class in that section.

Exhibitors must carry a current performance card for every Novice horse and make this available in the ring upon request. These must be signed by the Exhibitor or some person authorised to sign on their behalf and must be received before the closing date set.

STALLIONS :

No stallions allowed to compete in showing classes. Stallions competing in show jumping or breed classes must wear official stallion badges at all times and handlers/riders must wear approved armbands. **There are no Stallion stables/yards available on the grounds.**

HUNTER CLASSES:

Are open to all horses not entered in Hack, Park Hack or Riding Horse sections. Hack, Park Hack and Riding Horse sections are open to horses not entered in the hunter section. Exhibits in harness and hack classes can also compete in the driving, jumping and hunter classes where eligible.

CHAMPIONSHIP:

A horse/pony being eligible for championships must be ridden by the same rider as in the class or classes in which it qualified unless permission of the Horse Marshall and stewards has been obtained.

MEASURING/HEIGHT CERTIFICATES:

No measuring available at this Show. Measuring will be available prior to the Show. Details can be found on Wairarapa A&P's facebook page or contact the A&P office on 3798124.

Exhibitors must carry a height certificate for any class with a prescribed height or where a Certificate of Height is required and will be asked to show this certificate at any time. They may not leave the ring to obtain a certificate and will forfeit awards if certificate is not shown. Measuring Rules of The Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand will apply at this show.

No measuring available at this Show.

PERFORMANCE CARDS:

Valid performance cards **MUST** be carried **AT ALL TIMES**, and produced on request of a steward, or the rider will be disqualified from competing (i.e. prize money & ribbons will be forfeited, with no refund of entry fee).

PROTESTS:

Any protests must be lodged with the Horse Marshall within half an hour of results being posted, accompanied with a \$50 fee; to be forfeited if the complaint is not upheld.

All disputes will be settled by the judiciary committee consisting of the society's executive and marshal of the section.

CLEAN SPORT:

The Rules of the Royal A&P Society New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the person responsible's risk. Forbidden Substance - Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.

ARREARS:

No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other Show/Event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted. Lists of amounts owing at 8th November will be sent to RAS, ESNZ and secretaries of future events.

RAS YELLOW CARD SYSTEM:

This Show/Event supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system. A Yellow Card will be issued, In cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. Full wording of the 'Yellow Card' system is available to view on the RAS website – www.ras.org.nz.

AGE OF RIDERS OR HORSES:

Riders age and eligibility is determined as per the 1st of August. I.e. Riders/handlers who are of age for any division/section on 1st August complete the show year/season in that division/section.

Riders in horse rings (exhibits over 148cm) must be 12 years & over.

The age of the horse/pony is calculated as from the 1st August per ESNZ series rules

SADDLERY & ACCESSORIES:

Whips in ridden classes shall not exceed 76 centimetres in length.

Whips in lead rein and first ridden sections shall not exceed 68cm including the flap which shall measure no more than 2cm wide and 4cm long.

Whips in lead classes shall not exceed 145cm

Saddlecloths are optional however it is preferred that saddlecloths used and are at least are cut to the shape of the saddle.

Bearing reins, running reins or similar tack may not be used.

The misuse of a whip or spurs, or the committing of an act of cruelty by an exhibitor to his horse or pony within the limits of the showground, including rapping or misuse of a practice jump will be penalised.

Any such act must be reported by any horse/pony steward or judge to the Judicial or General committee.

In the interest of safety, the stirrup iron & the stirrup leather (this also applies to safety stirrups), must hang freely from the bar of the saddle and the outside of the flap. The rider must not directly or indirectly tie any part of their body to the saddlery, unless an exhibitor's disability card is held.

HATS & SAFETY HELMETS:

Wearing a hard hat is compulsory for anyone competing on, working in, or schooling or riding a horse/pony in any area considered to be part of the showground.

All riders must wear protective headgear with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area, collecting rings or anywhere else within the showground.

Helmets must meet the required safety standards as of 1 August 2017. Red tag must be visible on helmet harness.

Helmet Tagging will be available at the show, please contact horse secretary to arrange prior to the show.

SAFETY:

Each Exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Show grounds.

Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate Animal Legislation and the Health and Safety in Work Act 2015; and any amendments thereafter. All competitors compete at their own risk.

The Society reserves the right to refuse any competitor's entries without giving a reason.

MOTORBIKES/SCOOTERS:

May be ridden within grounds by licensed holders and not after 10pm.

DOGS:

Dogs are welcome at our show however they must be kept on leads and supervised at all times, any wandering or unsupervised dogs will be handed over to Carterton City Council Dog Control at the dog owners expense. No warnings will be issued.

MEDIA:

By entering or attending the Wairarapa A&P Show you accept that you may appear within differing media streams that are on location covering the event.

Your behaviour at the event and within the competition arena is at your discretion and is your responsibility.

Please note that there might be live streaming at the event therefore the camera is on throughout the day, there may also be several photographers on the grounds.

By entering the grounds you give permission for your photo to be taken and provided on their respective websites/facebook pages at the discretion of the photographer.

PRIZE MONEY PAYOUT POLICY

3 or less starts – 1st prize money only,

4 starters – 1st and 2nd prize money only,

5 plus entries – full prize money pay-out.

Show Jumping and Show Hunter Classes – full prize money pay-out as scheduled.

Animal Welfare is a priority for Wairarapa A & P. Any competitor seen using a harmful device will be asked to leave the grounds immediately without refund of any monies

ESNZ REGISTRATION AND LEVIES (All competitors please read)

\$5 ESNZ Jumping levy per equine, per show is included in the show jumping/show hunter levy pack.

Unregistered riders may compete in classes 80cm and under for ponies, and 90cm and under for horses on a \$15 introductory membership.

Registered riders may compete on unregistered horses in classes 80cm and under for ponies, and 90cm for horses, no additional levies required.

Registered riders may compete on unregistered horses in classes 100cm and under for ponies, and 110cm and under for horses with a \$20.00 casual jumping levy (excluding series classes and championships)

All other riders and horses **MUST** be full members with ESNZ. Results will not be recorded with ESNZ for Introductory classes.

Levy Information 2020-2021

\$5 ESNZ Jumping Levy (Compulsory) – payable by all horses/ponies competing in Jumping and or Show Hunter.

\$20 Casual Jumping Levy

The rider must be a full member with ESNZ. Horse/Pony not registered for ESNZ J/SH can compete using this levy.

The levy is \$20 for the show.

Can jump up to 1.00m on a pony and up to 1.10m on a horse. Cannot compete in series classes and will not be eligible for HOY points in SH.

Introductory Membership or \$15 Casual Membership Day Start

Riders may compete in Introductory class (80cm and under for ponies and 90cm and under for Horses) on an Introductory Membership or Casual Membership Day Start. All other riders must be full members with ESNZ – results will not be recorded with ESNZ for Introductory Classes.

Shows may choose to run registered classes at introductory heights where the rider must be a full ESNZ member and the horse may compete with a current Jumping/Show Hunter discipline start or on a Casual Jumping Levy – results for these classes will be recorded on ESNZ records where applicable

All other riders and horses **MUST** be full members with ESNZ. Results will not be recorded with ESNZ for Introductory classes.
