# Terms and Conditions

---

## Entry conditions

Online entries close with Main-Events.com on **Tuesday 19th October** or once event is at capacity. No postal or email entries will be accepted unless special arrangements are made with the show secretary. All entries will be expected to pay at the time of entry and will not be confirmed until full payment has been received. Late entries may be accepted with 50% late entry fee till 5pm night before the class.

## Fees and levies

**Ground Levy** \$20 per horse/pony.

**Medical/Admin levy** per rider \$25 (Non-Refundable)

**ESNZ Jumping levy** \$5 per horse/pony (compulsory)

**ESNZ Casual Jumping Levy** \$20 for horses and ponies not registered with ESNZ for the show - Horses may compete at 1.10m and below and Ponies 1m and below.

**ESNZ Casual Membership** \$15 per day for riders not registered with ESNZ only able to compete in Introductory classes.

- Stables/Covered Yards \$50 for show; Open yards \$25 for show. This must be pre-booked. (Preference will be given to those competing at higher levels). There are no refunds on stabling for scratchings received within two days of the show. If yards are left dirty, competitors will not have a yard allocated to them in the future. NOTE: there may be limited covered yards available due to the recent storm damage to our grounds.
- Refunds less 25% if notified to the event secretary by 7:00 pm three days prior to the show. Refunds after that less 50% at the committee's discretion.
- **Class changes** - 25% retained and no late fee charged. **LATE ENTRIES, SCRATCHINGS AND CHANGES IN ALL CLASSES MUST BE WITH THE SECRETARY BY 5:00PM THE NIGHT BEFORE** – draws will be updated by 7pm that evening, late entries to ride first in draw classes. Class changes must be completed online.
- Riders **MUST** check with the office before they leave the show to ensure they do not owe money. Otherwise, a \$25 admin fee may be charged for follow-up of any outstanding fees after the show. Note - this show will use the ESNZ Jumping Policy on Debt Collection to follow-up any unpaid accounts. Read more on the ESNZ website or see the policy at the show.
- Prize money will be paid out by direct credit within 14 days after the show so be sure to include your bank details with the online entry. Riders are responsible for checking their placings and prize money online within two days of the shows competition. No changes in prize money will be made after then.
- Any outstanding monies owed to the Wairarapa Area Jumping Group must be paid in full or your entries will be declined.
- In case of cancellation of the event the Medical/Admin fee and a percentage of entry fees will be retained to cover out of pocket expenses only.

## General conditions

1. All classes run under ESNZ rules.
2. Committee reserves the right to alter the programme.
3. Ring 1 to be run in strict catalogue order. All other rings will be in blackboard order unless otherwise specified.
4. Please ensure registrations and memberships are up to date. Failure to do so may result in loss of points, placings, prize money after the show and may result in rider being fined under ESNZ Jumping conditions.
5. Horses/ponies can compete under casual levy system for non-series classes and no higher than 1.10m for horses and 1.00m for ponies but riders must be fully registered. Introductory members can only compete in INTRODUCTORY level classes (named INTRO).
6. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. Committee reserves the right to evict and eliminate anyone who is acting in an unacceptable manner. Security may be patrolling the grounds.
7. Motorbikes are not to be ridden between the hours of 8pm and 6am. Motorbike riders must wear a helmet.

8. **No Dogs at this event** due to lambing. This is a health and safety issue and a requirement of the showgrounds management.
9. Photographers on the grounds are by application and/or invitation only. Any photographer outside of this may be asked to leave.
10. Competitors enter at own risk and the organisers take no responsibility for any injury to horses, riders or spectators or any damage to competitors or spectators property.
11. In completing your entry, you acknowledge you have read and understood the Covid-19 Requirements and will abide by them in full. Failure to comply will incur elimination without refund of your entries.
12. Food Trucks will be on site for the duration of the event.

**NOTE - We will not be running a Sunday evening BBQ at this show**

### **Show Hunter conditions**

1. All Equines must have a Current ESNZ Equine Registration and an Annual Jumping/Show Hunter Start to gain Horse of the Year Qualifying Points but can compete on a casual jumping levy WITHOUT earning points.
2. This is a Horse of the Year Qualifying Show for the 2021-2022 Season.
3. Ponies must compete in the correct category for ESNZ Hi Points classes.

### **IMPORTANT NOTICE to riders about MEDIA**

By entering or attending this competition, you accept that you may appear within differing media streams that are on location covering the event. Your behaviour at the event and within the competition arena is at your discretion and is your responsibility.

### **COVID-19 Level 2 requirements**

- **The show is closed to spectators.**
- You must be physically well to attend our event. If you are unwell, are awaiting test results, or displaying any Covid-19 symptoms you must stay home and must not attend the show.
- Only competitors and their immediate support (such as groom or truck driver) may attend the event. Every person entering the grounds MUST scan the QR codes at the entrance, and at your zone. Any guests who do not have a device to scan must complete a manual record of their attendance. Please advise the names of anyone attending the show with you as you complete your entries so we can allocate zones accordingly.
- Those requiring access to a shower will need to advise us with your entry as this will be important in allocating zones.
- To meet Level 2 requirements, our show must run in groups less than 100. You will be allocated a zone when you enter, and you must park and use facilities in this zone. When you leave your zone to compete in an arena, you must scan the QR code of the new zone. Zones will be provided prior to the event.
- You must wear a mask in any indoor areas such as ablution blocks and the Secretary Office. You must also wear a mask in outdoor areas where social distancing could be compromised, such as adjusting practice fences, at food caravans or water filling taps. If in doubt, please put a mask on. You are not required to wear a mask while you are riding, but are expected to keep a good distance from other riders.
- Please do not congregate in groups. Your support and commitment to Covid-19 requirements is super important to ensuring our sport can continue to operate under Level 2.
- Good personal hygiene practices should continue – wash and dry your hands before and after activities, cough into your elbow and don't touch your face.
- Failure to comply with these regulations may result in elimination and removal from the grounds.

### **ECPH Double or Quits**

- No extra cost to competitor. When the competitor rides into the ring they tell the judge whether they are riding for double or quits. The double only relates to 1st place.
- The competitor with the fastest time and has nominated double would get double first place prizemoney. If the total prizemoney for the class is e.g. class 2 the 1.20m horse is \$330 with first being \$120 a competitor would be able to win \$240.

- The competitor who nominates double and doesn't get the fastest time but gets another placing in the class would receive a ribbon for that placing but no prizemoney. Competitors that complete in these classes who nominate "quit" and get placed would receive the scheduled ribbons and prizemoney.

### **Wairarapa Area Points Prize**

The Wairarapa area is excited to announce a Points Series across the five shows in our area for the 2021/22 season. The Series will run across all 5 x shows in the Wairarapa Area:

1. Labour Weekend Show - Solway: 24&25 October 2021
2. Wairarapa A&P Show - Clareville: 28-30 October 2021
3. Wairarapa Area SJ & SH Show - Solway: 26&27 February 2022
4. Clareville Classic Show - Clareville: 25-27 March 2022
5. Glistening Waters Show - Solway: 1-4 April 2022

Points will be allocated to placegetters in the \* classes across these shows, and will be accumulated during the season. Overall series winners will be awarded at the final day of the Glistening Waters Show in April.
