Yarding Conditions

There are no horses to be left unattended tied to trucks or floats as per the NEC rules. All yards must be left clean.

There is limited covered horse accommodation available at the NEC. Covered yards will be allocated on the following basis -

- NEC Leased yard holders
- Sponsors
- Horses of rider's that are competing at 1.30m and above (includes all of these rider's horses)
- Horses of rider's that compete at 1.25m and above, attending all 3 days of the show (includes all of these rider's horses)
- Rider's competing on all three days of the show allocated on a first-in first-serve basis
- Any remaining yards will be allocated on a first in first serve basis
- The organizing group reserves the right to allocate outside of these priorities as they see fit

We will do our best to accommodate these priorities however this can be difficult with the covid requirements. If you wish to be in a bubble with others EACH PERSON MUST request this at time of entries by putting it in the yarding requests.

Entries close: Monday 28th March 2022 or when the show is at capacity

Payment: Payments are not required until Saturday 2nd April via direct credit. Please

enter early to help organisation, an invoice will be emailed prior to 2nd April in

which bank details will be included.

Late Entries: Entries made after Monday 28th March will incur a 50% late entry fee subject

to availability.

Changes: Class changes can be accepted via messages on Main-Events or email.

Class changes must be made before 6pm the day before the class, or 30 mins

after your last class whichever is the latest or at the discretion of the OC.

Scratchings must be made online at Main-Event messages or via email.

Scratchings made before the payment is due on 2nd April will occur no penalties. Scratching made before Friday 8th April will be refunded all entry fees,

not marked as non-refundable, less 25%.

Refunds & PrizeMoney: All yarding, camping and facility fees will be refunded in full.

Scratchings made after Thursday 7th March will receive no refund except with a vet or doctors certificate and then you will be refunded all entry fees, not

marked as non-refundable, less 50%.

All yarding, camping, and facility fees will be refunded in full.

All refunds and prize money will be paid electronically following the completion of the show. These will be paid into the bank account nominated on entry of the

account holder that completed the entry.

All advertised prize money will be paid and if required additional prize money will

be paid on a 1:7 ratio. Any queries must be made by the 1st May 2022.

No prize money or refunds will be paid out after that date.

General Conditions

Scratchings:

- All competitors enter at their own risk.
- By completing an entry all competitors agree to abide by the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 and both the show and the National Equestrian Centres health and safety policies.
- The organizing group reserves the right to alter or cancel any classes at any time.
- The organizing group reserves the right to change or amend the schedule, including prize money at any time.
- The organizing group reserves the right to refuse and or cancel an entry with no reason required.
- The organizing group decisions are final.
- If an 'act of god' event occurs (including COVID-19) that requires the event to be canceled the following refund applies. Before 2nd April no payments are required. After the 2nd April full refund of all fees except the covid fees.
- Formal dress in all rings on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
- The ring will run strictly in draw order and you must ride in your allocated slot.
- Unless judges permission is granted Horses/ponies must be ridden in draw order and riders must be at the gate ready to compete. If not a 3 minute warning bell will be rung, which will result in the elimination of the combination if still not available at the conclusion of 3 minutes.
- All fees and prize money are inclusive of GST.
- All riders, horses, and ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ registration.
- Parents are responsible for children under the age of 18 at all times.
- The ESNZ drug and alcohol policy will be enforced at this show. Underage drinking and the use of illegal drugs will not be tolerated.
- Dogs are welcome at the show but must be on a leash at all times. This applies to all parts of the property, including the XC course and hacking areas. Dogs are not allowed in any building. Owners are required to pick up any droppings and dispose of them in the skip bins. Failure to comply will result in the dog having to be removed from the grounds.
- Riders must wear a wristband appropriate to their bubble at all times. Each rider must supply a volunteer.
