Equifest Fees

1. A \$25 non-refundable admin and medic fee applies per rider
2. A \$55 ground fee per horse applies
3. Each rider receives 1 x wristband. Extra wristbands can be purchased via Main Events when you enter \$45 (\$30 saving) these are limited to 4 x extra wristbands.
4. Open yards \$45 and covered yards \$100 for the duration of the event.
5. Stables \$180 for the duration of the event. All stallions must be stabled when not being ridden. (stables & covered yards are limited)
6. Camping: Non-powered sites are \$50 per site up to 5 people camping on site

General conditions

All races are run and all equipment is set as per IMGGA 2022 rulebook.

Open Teams must be made from within either the North or South Island. Riders can be from any Branch as long as the Branches are from the same Island. Riders do not have to currently reside in the Island that they are representing, but do have to be financial members of an NZMGA Branch in that Island. If a team cannot be made up with riders from the same Island, then a mixed Island team can be made only after all teams have 5 riders.
