Notes

- Teams from any Pony Club may win the competition and receive the first place ribbons, but only a Christchurch Pony Club Branch may hold the shield.
- Classes may be deleted or altered if there are insufficient entries.
- Minimum 4 riders per team, maximum 5 riders per team.
- Assistance definition – Assistant can hold the pony while the rider mounts and restrain the pony for safety reasons but cannot assist rider to steer the pony or handle equipment.
- Bits – Check the NZPCA website to see that your bit is allowed for games.
