Competitors qualifying for final heat in any horse event must ride the same horse as ridden in qualifying heat. The Committee reserves the right to make any alteration to the programme. Any protest must be lodged with the Secretary within 15 minutes of events, accompanied by a fee of \$50. The Ground Jury's decision is final. A Pleasure Mount: Is a horse/pony maintained for pleasure, personal enjoyment or casual riding. Pleasure classes will be a Qualifying Show for NZEPS Members, snaffle bit only. No drop noseband, Cavesson noseband only. No spurs, whips no longer than 76cm. Any rider under 17 years competing on a horse must ride in adult ring. **Champion & Reserve:** Judged from winners in: Best Trotting, Best Combination, Best Paced/Mannered, Most Suitable for Learner Rider. All entry fees must be paid before competing. To be eligible for events run under New Zealand Equestrian Federation Rules, all horses and ponies

domiciled within the area, must be registered.

EVENTS MAY COMBINED IF NOT ENOUGH NUMBERS "LOCAL" Defined as school bus route including Waimarama turn off and also inclusive of Havelock North Pony Club members.
